

Dear Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in the Fort Bend ISD Academy Programs. The high school Academies offer specialized programs for academic achievement in a variety of career clusters.

In order for your application to be considered, **you MUST reside within the Fort Bend ISD Attendance Zone.** (If you reside or attend school outside the FBISD attendance zone and are accepted, you must provide proof of residency within the zone by the first day of August in order to be registered). If you qualify, **please complete the attached application and give it to your school counselor.**

A complete application will have no blank spaces and include the following:

1. One-page **Academy Application** and one page **Commitment Form**. *Make sure you indicate to which Academy you are applying.*
2. One-page handwritten **essay**. The topic for your essay is "Why I am interested in the (requested) Academy, and what strengths I can bring to the program." **Include your name and the name of the Academy on your essay.** If you are applying to more than one Academy, write a separate essay for each Academy.
3. **Two teacher recommendations** (forms attached). *Recommendations must be from core subject teachers. (Applicants to the Medical Science, Engineering, and the Math and Science Academies **must** submit one recommendation from a current math teacher and one from a current science teacher.) Teachers should give completed recommendations to the school counselor, not back to the applicant. In cases where the applicant does not currently attend a FBISD school, the applicant should provide each recommending teacher with a stamped envelope, and the teacher should mail the recommendations to the Director of Academy Programs.*

Students not currently attending a FBISD school will submit the application to the Director of Academy Programs. In this case, the complete application must also include the following:

4. A copy of your most recent and last year's report cards - **not progress reports**. *(This information will be electronically accessed for FBISD students).*
5. A copy of your most recent TAKS scores. *If you do not currently attend a FBISD school, submit scores from standardized tests you have taken in the last year. (This information will be electronically accessed for FBISD students).*

Your application will not be reviewed until it is complete.

If you want to hear more about our academy programs before submitting your application, please attend our district **Academy Expo October 26 from 6:30-8:30 PM at Wheeler Fieldhouse.**

Deadlines for submitting complete applications to individual academies are posted on the application and on the district website www.fortbendisdacademies.com. Applications received after the scheduled due date will be reviewed only as space is available.

You will be notified of the academy's affirmative decision in January. To guarantee your position, you must sign and return a letter of commitment.

Commitment Form

Criteria for Remaining in an FBISD High School Academy

With acceptance comes responsibility. Students are provided every opportunity to be successful in their chosen Academy. All Academy students are expected to display exemplary behavior, pass all courses, **and** meet academic proficiencies in all Academy courses. However, violations in grades and conduct (as outlined below) will constitute probation and/or dismissal. Parents will receive written notice via US mail of cases warranting probation or dismissal.

Probation Violations:

1. The student has three or more unexcused absences in any nine-week period (3 tardies = 1 unexcused absence).
2. The student falls below academic proficiency in Academy classes at the end of the semester. The student will have one semester to return to the expected academic performance or he/she will be dismissed. The student will remain on probation for the duration of time that he/she is enrolled in the Academy.

Dismissal Violations:

1. Failure of any course at the end of the year will result in dismissal from the Academy and return to zoned campus.
2. Students will be dismissed from the Academy **at the end of the semester** for two In School Suspensions (ISS), one Out of School Suspension (OSS), and/or assignment to the Campus Alternative Education Program (CAEP). Any student removed from an Academy for academic or disciplinary reasons must return to his/her zoned campus at the end of the semester following completion of the disciplinary assignment.
3. Serious behavioral offenses requiring placement in the District Alternative Education Program (DAEP) at the M.R. Wood Campus will result in **immediate** dismissal from the Academy.
