

Rainy Day Procedures

To determine if rainy day dismissal will be called, please refer to the following explanation to understand the weather conditions that must be present.

Rainy Day Dismissal:

- 1.) Moderate to heavy rain is present at 2:50 p.m.
- 2.) Anytime thunder and lightening occurs

Please talk to your child about his/her rainy day dismissal plan. At the beginning of the school year, every parent completes a form indicating the rainy day plan for your child. You and your child are responsible for that plan. Make sure that your child understands what to do in the event SWE must have a rainy day dismissal. Your child's plan may not be to walk home. Students will not be permitted to use the phone until after dismissal has concluded, so it is imperative that you talk to your child ahead of time and make sure that he or she understands their rainy day plan. If you need to change your child's rainy day plan, please email or call your child's teacher.

We also request that you do not call the school before 2:50 p.m. to ask if it will be rainy day dismissal. We will not be making that decision before that time. Thank you for understanding that we have nearly 800 students, and we need your help by planning in advance. Although we will do our best to make sound decisions concerning dismissal, we cannot control the weather. Unfortunately, dismissal will take longer on rainy days and we greatly appreciate your patience.
