2014 BOND UPDATE




This spring, construction is reaching its peak in Fort Bend ISD's \$484 million bond program. Construction of three new elementary schools and classroom additions at six other campuses continues, and renovations are also underway at FBISD's existing campuses.

The \$484 million 2014 Bond Program included funding for a total of four new schools, improvements to Career and Technical Education and technology and safety upgrades... promising to touch every school in Fort Bend ISD!

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Construction and renovation work is broken into three phases, with all projects set for completion by June 2019.
Here's how the money has been spent to date:



PHASE ONE


- · 45% complete
- All campuses have been bid, negotiated and are under construction.
- 30 campuses are in the construction phase
- 2 bid packages are in closeout and warranty phase
- Sullivan Elementary: Complete
- Patterson, Neill and Leonetti Elementary: Construction underway

PHASE **TWO**

- · 5% complete
- All professional services contracts executed
- All design activities completed
- 26 campuses are in construction phase
- 4 campuses in procurement phase

PHASE THREE

- · 2% complete
- 3 professional services contracts executed
- 4 professional services contracts are in the process

Technology 2014 Bond Program:

2,741.38 miles (roughly the distance from Sugar Land to Salt Lake City and back) of fiber cable has been installed at FBISD schools and sites, allowing wireless internet access upgrades at all 11 high schools and all 14 middle schools. Installation is now beginning at the District's elementary schools, with all wi-fi deployment scheduled for completion by summer of 2018.
