Select the Career (field of study) you would like to apply:

Semester Credit Hour

This career is for students seeking college credit or wanting to attend college level courses. This Career offers Certificates of Completion; Associate degrees in Arts, Sciences, Teaching and Applied Science. Students may transfer credit to other colleges or universities. Some coursework may be taken for no credit.

International students seeking an F1 student visa, or students wanting to study in the Intensive English Program MUST select this career.

Oual Credit

This career is for high school students taking a college course to earn both college and high school credit. Dual credit courses are typically taught at the high school.

Adult High School

This career is a high school credit recovery program for current or previous high school students age 17 years or older, who need 2 credit or less to graduate. A high school diploma is awarded either by the student's home school or by HCC.

Continuing Education

The Continuing Education Career offers non-credit opportunities for workforce training, career development and lifelong learning. Classes are career focused, fast-tracked, and start monthly. Courses offered on campus and online.

Non Credit

The Non Credit career offers learning opportunities to meet the changing needs of the community, business and industry. Generally there are no entrance requirements although some courses may have age restrictions or prerequisites.
