Summer Middle School Programs

2016 Middle School Remedial Course Offerings

The Remedial Middle School program will be offered in two sessions. Only one course can be taken per session. Students who need to repeat two courses must successfully complete both sessions in order to be promoted to the next grade level based on home campus procedures.

Summer School is offered to students who did not successfully complete courses previously taken in grades 6, 7 or 8 during the 2015-2016 school year that are needed to be promoted to the next grade level.

*If an 8th grade student fails Algebra I during the regular school year, he/she must take and pass 8th grade math in Summer School to satisfy the math requirement for promotion to the 9th grade.

2016 Middle School 8th Grade **Accelerated Instruction Program**

The Student Accelerated Instruction Program is designed to provide students the opportunity to be academically successful on the third administration of the Reading and Math STAAR assessment. This program will be offered to current eighth graders. Middle school counselors will submit qualified students to summer school administrators for registration.

Transportation

There is no tuition for this program and transportation will be provided from elementary cluster school locations. Fort Bend ISD does not provide supervision at any of the summer school cluster pick-up/drop-off bus stops, and all grade levels (elementary, middle, and high school) are picked up and dropped off at the same bus stops.

Pre-AP High School Courses

Incoming ninth graders for the 2016-2017 school year may register for Pre-AP Courses: Pre-AP Geometry (if they have successfully completed Algebra I).

Tuition for Pre-AP credit courses for FBISD students toward high school graduation is \$650 per 1.0 credit and \$325 for students who are currently served by the Free and Reduced Lunch Program and transportation is not provided.

Original High School Courses

(see HS Summer School Brochure for more information)

Incoming ninth graders for the 2016-2017 school year may register for Original Credit Courses: Art, Professional Communications (Speech), Health, or PE during the summer of 2016. Successful completion of each semester (session) earns 0.5 credit towards high school graduation. Registration forms and information are available from your middle school counselor.

Course work will be done at Elkins High School.

Tuition for original credit courses for FBISD students towards high school graduation is is \$260 per course (0.5 credit) and \$130 per course (0.5 credit) for students who are currently served by the Free and Reduced Lunch Program and include transportation.

Registration Process

Online Registration

Pre-AP, AP and Original Credit Courses Date: April 4 – June 7, 2016 at 5:00 pm.

Students must completed registration form and return form to the campus counseling office before selecting and paying online.

** All online registrations without payment will be dropped weekly and the course must be reselected in Family Access before making a payment.

Remedial Credit Courses

Date: June 1 - June 7, 2016, at 5:00 pm.

** All online registrations without payment will be dropped daily and the course must be reselected in Family Access before making a payment.

Students may avoid summer school walk-in registration by selecting courses and paying online with a credit/debit card through Fort Bend ISD's Family Access – go to www.fortbendisd.com (Family Access is an icon at the top right side of the home page.)

Parents may contact the FBISD Customer Support Center at 281-634-1300 for Family Access assistance.

Cash only payments may be made between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. at the Fort Bend ISD Administration Building Business & Finance Office (16431 Lexington Blvd., Sugar Land 77479).

Parents or students must bring all Registration Forms completed, signed by the campus counselor, and courses must be selected in Family Access before coming to the Administration Building to pay.

Payment will only be accepted at the Administration building if the above steps have been completed.

Parents and students will be instructed to attend Walk-in Registration on June 8 (High School) or June 9 (Middle School), 2016, if they are unable to access Family Access to select the appropriate course.

Class Assignments

Classes are assigned by the summer school administrative team based on enrollment, need and the availability of certified teachers. Classes will be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or lack of certified teachers and will result in a full refund or the opportunity to select an other available class.

Grades

Progress reports will be given to students for Session I and Session II on the seventh day of each session. Final grades **will be mailed** to the student's home at the conclusion of each summer school session.

Transportation

Transportation will be provided for FBISD summer school students. Pick-up and drop-off locations will be provided during registration. Bus stops during the summer will be at cluster elementary locations

Attendance Policy

Efficient use of class time is essential to the student's success. Students will be withdrawn without receiving a grade for the course and without receiving a refund if they have more than two (2) absences during Session I or Session II, regardless of the date of the third absence. A student is marked absent after missing the first 30 minutes of a class. Three tardies in a class will be counted as one (1) absence. Refunds will not be given to students who are withdrawn for excessive absences/tardiness.

Dress Code

All students attending summer school in FBISD will be required to follow the FBISD dress code and grooming policies. Students refusing to adhere to these policies after a second (2nd) warning will be withdrawn from summer school without receiving a grade for the session regardless of the date within the session on which the incident occurs. Refunds will not be given to students who are withdrawn because of dress and grooming violations.

Discipline Policy

All students will follow the FBISD Student Code of Conduct. Students receiving a second (2nd) discipline referral will be withdrawn from summer school without receiving a grade for the session regardless of the date within the session. In addition, physical and/or verbal confrontations on campus or on the school bus, which are deemed to cause a major disruption of the educational environment and/or impair the driver's operation of the school bus, will result in the student being immediately withdrawn from summer school, without receipt of a grade for the session regardless of the date within the session on which the incident occurs.

Refunds will not be given to students who are withdrawn for disciplinary reasons.

Refund Policy

Students who are withdrawn from summer school or removed from the bus for disciplinary reasons or who are withdrawn because of excessive tardiness/absences will not receive any refund for fees paid on behalf of the student. Refunds will not be given once classes begin on the first day of each summer school session. All allowable requests for refunds must be made in writing to the summer school principal and approved by the principal. A \$25 processing fee will be deducted from each approved refund. Refunds will be given due to the cancellation of classes and will not be subject to a processing fee. Allow up to 4 weeks processing time.
