Dear Parent and/or Guardian,

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) has identified our campus under the PEG Program for the 2017-18 school year. Schools are included on the PEG list if passing rates on STAAR are less than or equal to 50 percent in any two of the preceding three years or were rated Improvement Required by the state accountability system in 2014, 2015 or 2016.

Our campus was identified for the 2017-18 PEG list as our passing rates on 2016 STAAR were less than or equal to 50 percent in the area of Science in 2014, Writing, Social Studies and Science in 2015, and Writing and Social Studies in 2016.

I can share with you that we have strategies in place to improve our academic standing as well as to offer students many extracurricular opportunities. Our goal is that Christa McAuliffe Middle School will not be identified on the PEG list in the future.

Under the PEG inter-district transfer provision, a parent of a student enrolled in any of the identified PEG campuses may make an application to transfer to a campus tuition-free in any other school district for the 2017–18 school year. Please note that a school district chosen by a student’s parent under this statute is entitled to accept or reject the application for the student to attend school in that district but may not use criteria that discriminates on the basis of a student’s race, ethnicity, academic achievement, athletic abilities, language proficiency, sex, or socioeconomic status. Parents may also request a transfer to another school in FBISD that is open for transfers. However, transportation is not provided to the new campus and would solely be the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian.
