More Student Drop-Off/Pick-Up Concerns

Student safety is our top priority here at Travis High School! With that in mind, please note the following:

1. There is **NO PARENT DROP-OFF or PICK-UP** in the student parking lot in the mornings and afternoons. ***Starting today (Monday, April 11th), the exit lane to the student parking lot in the mornings will be blocked off.***

2. Parents are **HIGHLY DISCOURAGED** from picking up students on Harlem Road after school. This poses a direct threat to student safety as well as safety of the other drivers on Harlem Road as cars are unexpectedly pulling out of the right lane into traffic after picking up their student(s).



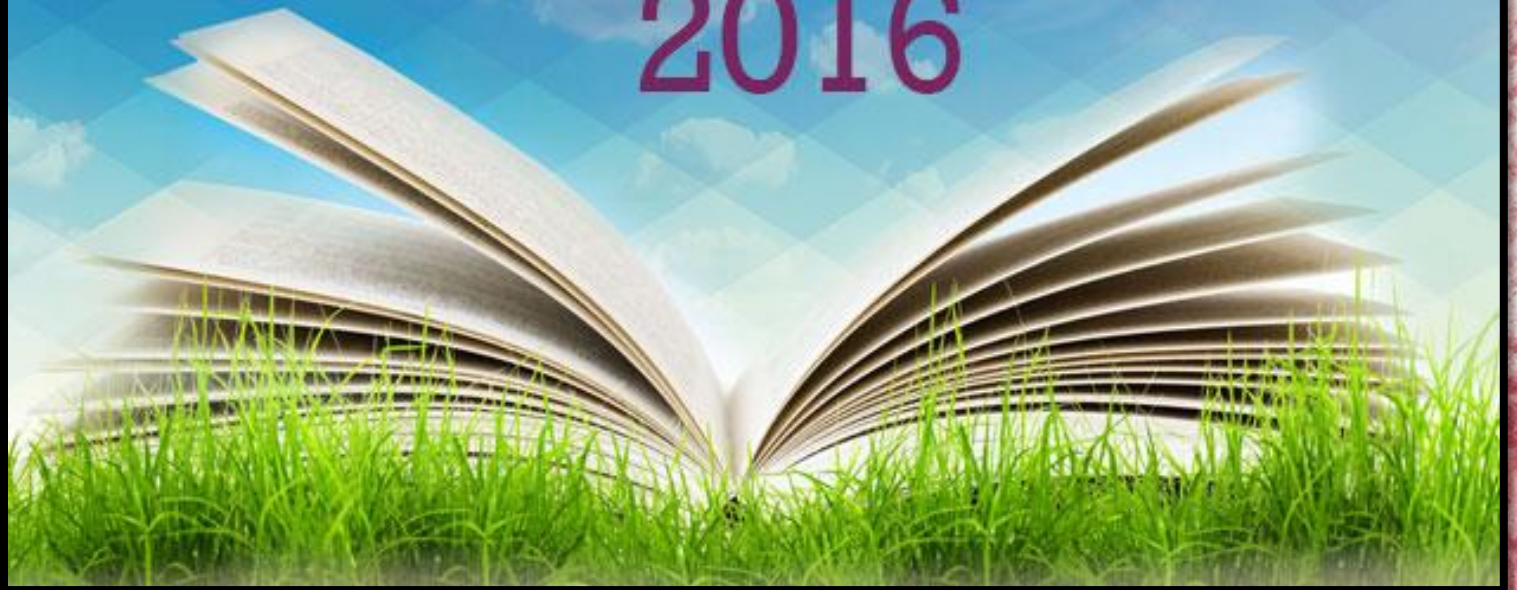
