## **FBISD Spring Semester Exam Exemptions 2016**

Note: For some students exemption eligibility criteria includes passing an End of Course Exam (EOC). If a student has not passed the EOC exam for that course they are not eligible to be exempt from the spring semester exam in that course. If EOC scores are not received from TEA prior to the start of spring semester final exams then the exemption criteria will only be based on attendance, discipline, fines/fees, and grades.

### 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Grade

Attendance: No more than 4 absences for the spring semester. 3 tardies equals 1 absence for exemption purposes.

Discipline: No removals to DAEP/JJAEP in the spring semester.

Fines/Fees: No outstanding fines or fees.

Grades: Must have a semester average of 80 or above for the spring semester in the course eligible for exemption.

State Testing: Must have met minimum standard on the EOC exam for the course eligible for exemption. Exemptions: Eligible for 3 exemptions in core courses only. (Math, Science, ELA, or Social Studies)

Test Days: Students must attend class during exam exemptions to receive exemptions.

11<sup>th</sup> Grade

Attendance: No more than 4 absences for the spring semester. 3 tardies equals 1 absence for exemption purposes.

Discipline: No removals to DAEP/JJAEP in the spring semester.

Fines/Fees: No outstanding fines or fees.

Grades: Must have a semester average of 80 or above for the spring semester in the course eligible for exemption. State Testing: Must have met minimum standard on the EOC exam for the course eligible for exemption (US History).

Exemptions: Eligible for 4 exemptions in core courses only. (Math, Science, ELA, or Social Studies)

Test Days: Students must attend class or all required activities during exam exemptions to receive exemptions.

12<sup>th</sup> Grade

Attendance: No more than 4 absences for the spring semester. 3 tardies equals 1 absence for exemption purposes.

Discipline: No removals to DAEP/JJAEP in the spring semester.

Fines/Fees: No outstanding fines or fees.

Grades: Must have a semester average of 80 or above for the spring semester in the course eligible for exemption. State Testing: Must have met minimum standard on the EOC exam for the course eligible for exemption (US History).

Exemptions: Eligible for exemptions in *all* courses.

Test Days: Students must attend class or all required activities during exam exemptions to receive exemptions.
