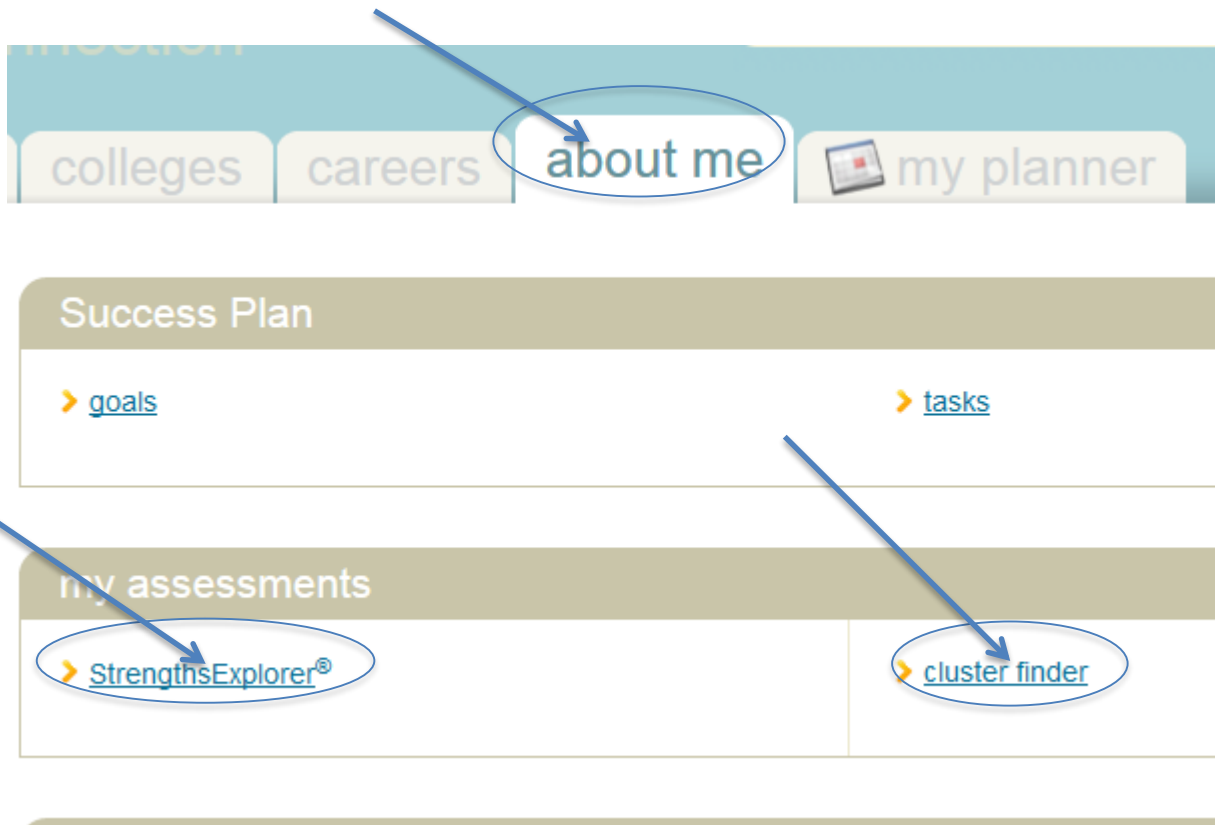

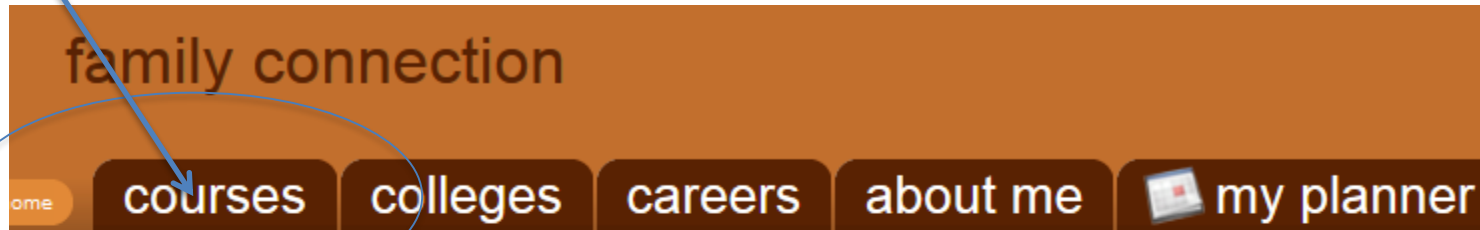

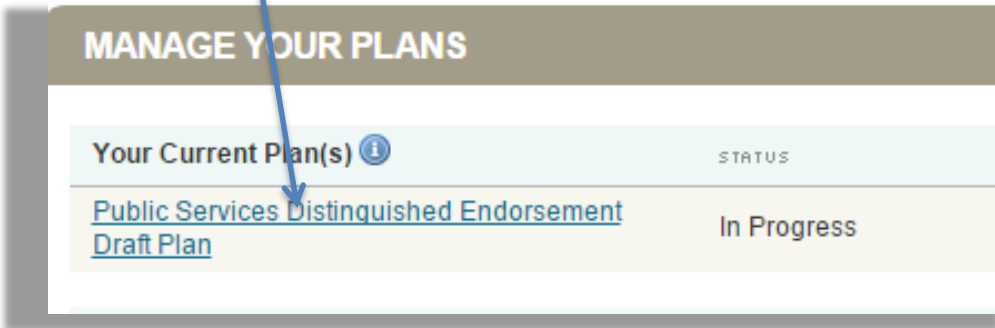

Select Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, and one full credit or a combination of two half credits from the following: Math Models with Applications (must be taken before Algebra II); Pre-calculus; Independent Study Math; Advanced Quantitative Reasoning; AP Statistics; AP Computer Science; AP Calculus AB; AP Calculus BC; College Prep Mathematics, or Dual Credit Mathematics. 1*

Additional Math credits beyond the 4 required may be selected in electives.

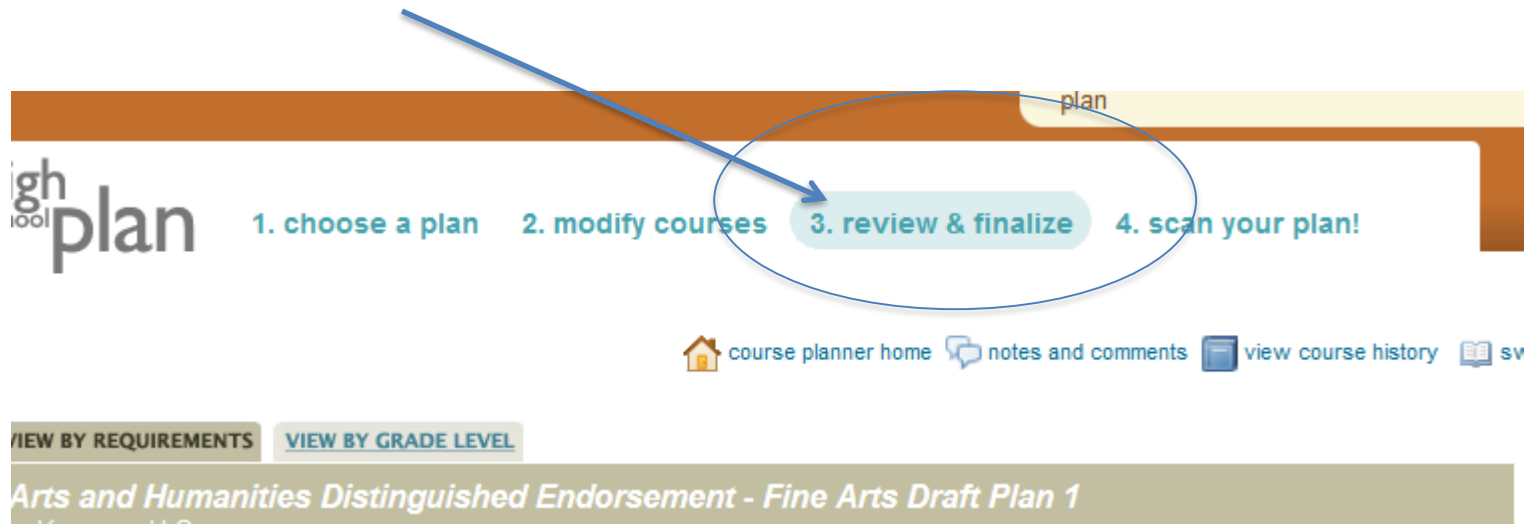

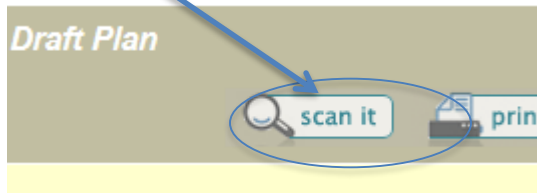

Once a plan has been completed, students may scan their plan to see how well their plan prepares them for various types of colleges. This option is not available for 8th grade.

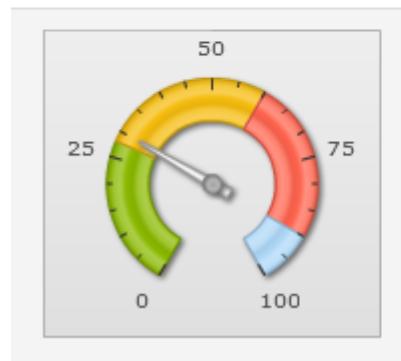

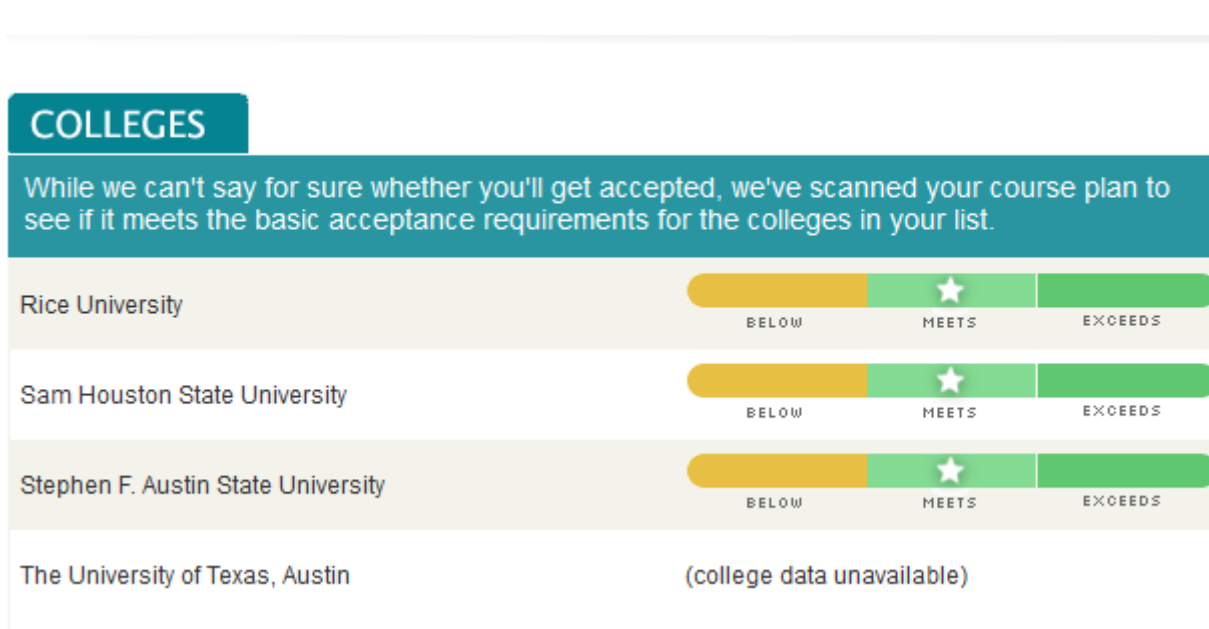

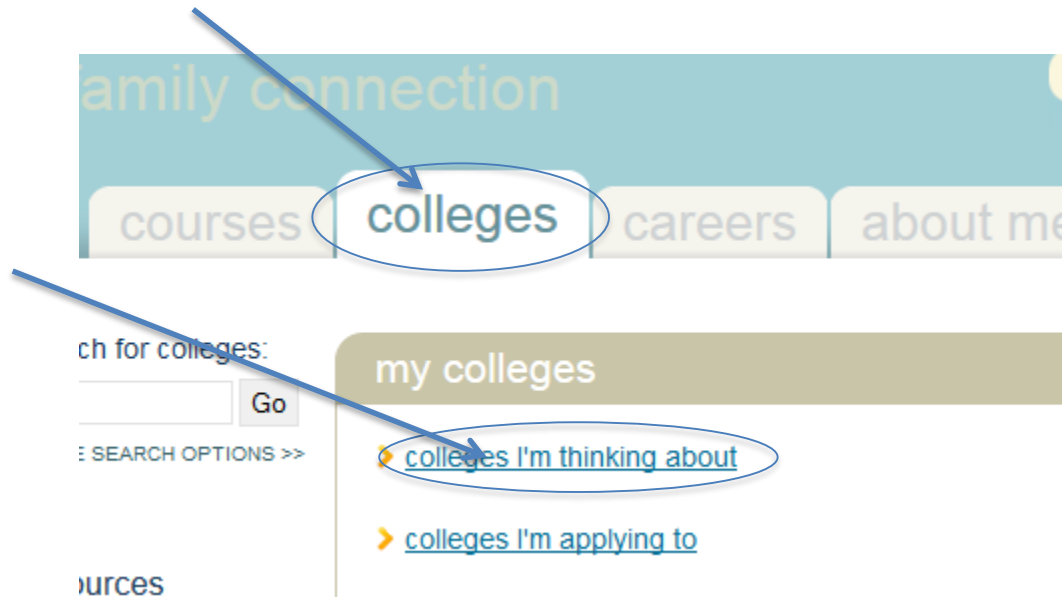
