

Advisor Information Session 2021-2022

1. YIP Overview

- 200 Juniors and Seniors (over 500 students apply)
- 5 school districts, private schools and homeschool
- 8-10 Teams of about 15-20 students
- Orientation & Evaluation Sessions are Mandatory
- Must attend 3 of the 4 Nonprofit Sessions
- Nonprofits must be located in Fort Bend County
 - i. Each nonprofit submits an application of project request.

2. YIP Session Dates

- October 9 Orientation UHSL Mandatory
- November 6 Volunteer Session 1 Meet at UHSL
- December 4 Volunteer Session 2 Meet at UHSL
- January 8 Volunteer Session 3 Meet at UHSL
- February 5 Volunteer Session 4 Meet at UHSL
- March 5 Evaluation UHSL Mandatory
- Sessions are 9:00 am 3:00 pm. Show up at 8:45 am to sign in.

3. Transportation

- Students responsible to get to each session. Pick up at 3:00 pm.
- Students will ride buses to each nonprofit session.
- Students cannot leave a session early.

4. Online Application

- Applications will open on August 16, 2021
- Applications are due on September 10, 2021, 11:59 PM
- Parent Signatures must be received by September 10th. Should a student have issues with electronic signature or parental support, counselors should reach out to Ammie Blahuta.

5. Team Evaluations

- Together each team awards the nonprofits with a grant of \$1,000-2.000
- Students have to work together and share with the whole group on what they have learned

6. YIP Scholarship

- Applications will be online through same database system
- Only students who attend Orientation, Evaluation and 3 of 4
 Volunteer Sessions will be eligible to apply
- Applications are reviewed by Community Volunteers
- Scholarship awards are determined by the funds raised by the community
- Applications will be due March 25, 2022

7. Investment in Youth Luncheon (Safari Texas)

- Wednesday, April 20 or 27, 2022
- Advisors will coordinate with the district on transportation (each district provides their own transportation)
- Students should arrive between 10:30-11:30 AM
- Only those YIP Students who have completed the program may attend
- Each school is asked to bring (3) potential YIP Students for 2022-2023
- Scholarships will be announced at the luncheon
- Community Members, District Leaders, TGF Trustees, etc. all attend luncheon (over 900 in attendance)
