Qualities of students in an Advanced Academic Class: independent problem solver, timely with work, organized, proactive, advocate for self, active listener, and consistently prepared for class.

1. Supplies required daily in class:

Personal Supplies

- 4 1 subject spirals (1 for each grading term)
- Folder (for homework/graded work)
- #2 Pencils
- Scissors
- Highlighters
- Pencil Sharpener
- Tape or Glue Sticks
- Markers or colored pencils
- Dry erase markers (no yellow; for personal use)

Classroom Supplies

• 1 – package of notebook paper to be collected for classroom (graph paper optional)

2. The classroom norms are:

- Be respectful at all times.
- Be prepared. (Having all materials needed for class including homework)
- Be on time.

3. **Quizzes/checkpoints** will be given to check for student comprehension and counted as daily grades throughout each nine week grading period. Quizzes can be used to help review for tests.

4. **Math work** is to be <u>**neat**</u> and in <u>**pencil**</u>. This allows for neater error corrections as problems are worked. Students <u>**must show their work/process**</u> for all assignments. **Not showing work can lead to point penalties.**

5. Late Work/Make-Up Work/Re-Testing Policies: See Student Handbook for policies.

- 1 day late (-10)
- 2 days late (-20)
- 3 days late (-30)
- After 5 days highest grade possible is a 50.

6. **Worksheets:** If a student loses his/her homework worksheet, they can call a friend and have it copied or access Schoology lesson folder if provided.

7. **Tutorial Day** for Math is **THURSDAY** morning starting at **8:20 am**. Students do not need a pass but must arrive in the classroom by **8:25 am**.

8. **Schoology:** Schoology will be used for communication, calendaring, assignment posting, class notes, review boards, and many other things.
