OPTIONAL PATHWAYS:

- A coherent sequence of courses for four or more credits in CTE: (1) Agriculture, Food, and Natural Resources, (2)
 Marketing, (3) Architecture & Construction, (4) Information Technology, (5) Arts, Audio/Video Technology &
 Communications, (6) Manufacturing, (7) Business Management & Industry, (8) Hospitality & Industry, (9)
 Transportation, Distribution, & Logistics, (10) Finance.
- 2. Four English electives from the following areas in three levels: (1) Debate, (2) Public Speaking, (3) Newspaper, (4) Yearbook, (5) Broadcast Journalism.
- 3. Four technology applications credits by selecting from the following: (1) Digital Design and Media production, (2) Web Communication, (3) Digital Art and Animation, (4) Web Design, (5) 3-D Modeling and Animation, (6) Web Game Development, (7) Digital Communications in the 21st Century, (8) Digital Video and Audio Design.
- 4. A coherent sequence of four credits from (1), (2), or (3).
