

Art Club Application 2023-24

Dear PGE student and parents,

Art Club is an accelerated art class offered by Mrs. Vontz, two Tuesdays a month after school. It is a chance to expand the art skills of young artists, promote creativity, and practice independence as students complete several independent art projects throughout the year. Art Club students will participate in local art shows and compete in art contests at the state level. Applications are open to interested students who are in **fourth and fifth grade only and show a strong interest and passion for art**. Students will need to submit an art piece with their application. To maintain the quality of instruction only twenty applicants will be selected to attend the group. To be considered for the club students must:

- **Students/parents must complete THIS FORM.**
- Students must: Score top marks on a rubric assessment filled out by art teacher (sample copy attached for your reference)
- Show effort, creativity in interpretation, and skill in the required art piece to be submitted with the application. **(See directions below)**
- Maintain acceptable academic and behavior expectations according to the Student Code of Conduct and Student/Parent Handbook.
- Be picked up promptly at 5:00. Students may **NOT** walk home alone.
- Pay \$25 Art dues which will cover special supplies, and entry fee for the Texas Elementary Art Meet.
- Regular attendance is required. Students who miss more than two meetings (for reasons other than documented illness) will be replaced with someone on the waiting list.

Students will be informed by letter **by September 30, 2024** of acceptance into the club or notification of being placed on the wait list for future consideration. Invitation to the Art Club is based on a score of combined factors: student interest, parental consent, recommendation and assessment of skill from the child's art teacher. Such factors as motivation, responsibility, and behavior are considered as well as artistic ability. Artwork must be included with the application. **If accepted students will be asked to pay a \$25 supply fee/dues through Revtrak.**



- You **may** use any media you like, such as paint, markers, crayons, etc.
- You **may not** trace or use any copyrighted images (one someone else has created)
- You **may not** receive help from others such as friends, parents, or siblings.
- Use good composition and skills you've learned in art, like filling the page, adding details, etc.
- Above all: ***Do your best!! Be creative and show me what YOU KNOW ABOUT ART. Remember : You must do this on your own...NO HELP ALLOWED!!!***
