## PROGRESSIVE Testing

In math, we use progressive testing. What this means is there are not formal retests. Instead, we build the retest into the follow test. Then if you make a higher grade on the following test, that grade will replace the first test grade. This is the only way to bring up a test grade.

Example: Original Test 1 grade: 75

Original Test 2 grade: 90

Then in Skyward, both Test 1 and Test 2 will be 90.

## LATE WORK Policy

There is a school wide late work policy. Students have up to 5 school days to turn in late work. Each day that the work is late, 10 points will be taken off their grade. That means if a student turns in the work 5 days late, the highest grade they can earn is a 50.

Missing work will be labeled missing in Skyward. Once the 5-day late policy passes, it will no longer have that label.
