#### **Rules and Procedures**

In addition to the Ridge Point High School Rules, the following rules and policies will be in effect at all times.

### Respect

Yourself, your peers, your teacher (this includes subs and other adult visitors), the art room, and all supplies.

#### **Tardies**

Teachers will follow the RPHS tardy policy

- Doors will be locked at tardy bell
- Student will be marked tardy in Skyward
- Students reporting to class after first 20 minutes of class will be marked absent as per FBISD policy

# **Cell phones**

- As per the NEW school/district policy, cell phone may NOT be used for classwork.
- Each student has been assigned a laptop which will be used for any computer work.
- ALL cell phones will be put in a numbered shelf for each student upon entering the art room daily.
- Students' refusal to comply with this will result in:
  - 1st time: Confiscate device return at the end of the school day
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> time: Confiscate and Parent contact made
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> time: Confiscate, parent notified, and discipline referral written.

### **Restroom Passes**

- No restroom passes during the first or last 10 minutes of class.
- Only one student out at a time.
- Must have plastic pass when using the restroom.
- If someone is out and there is a restroom emergency, see the teacher for emergency pass.

#### **Art Fee**

### • A \$60 ART FEE IS REQUIRED FROM ALL ART STUDENTS.

- A parent/guardian MUST contact your art teacher (email or written note) if there is financial difficulty in paying this fee.
- Students who have not paid this fee by September 15th, 2023, will be added to RPHS Fines & Fees List. These students also will not receive the art supply kit needed to work during class.
- Students will receive their assigned shelf to keep tools in after paying the fee.
- All 3D students will be given an art tool kit. This will be returned at the end of the year.
- Any missing items will result in student paying for the item to be replaced.

#### **REMIND 101:**

- All students and at least 1 parent is required to join the class Remind 101 messaging group for his/her class period. (both parents may join if desired)
- This is for a GRADE. Directions on how to join are in the <u>class resources folder</u>. Directions will also be shared via email and in class.
- Students must turn in two screen shots: their own and their parents acceptance message into the group for their complete 100 grade.
- If only 1 person joins, the grade is a 50.
- Important information regarding tutorials, due dates and other class matters is shared via Remind. Parents and students can also use it to contact me via text out of school hours & weekends. Although I am available via email & phone, the fastest way is to use Remind to contact me.
- If your child doesn't have a phone, please contact me.

# **REQUIRED** End of Year Art Show – will be held MAY 9TH (after school @ RPHS)

- All Art 1 students MUST PARTICIPATE AND ATTEND THE ART SHOW
- Art Show is 2 MAJOR GRADES (Creating a theme & displaying Artwork & Attendance).
- students will show 1 of their best work from the year and compete to get "Best in Show" awards in different categories.
- Alternative assignments will be provided for those who cannot attend (you still must display artwork).
- Family & friends are encouraged to attend! 😂

#### Food/Drink

- WATER ONLY.
- No eating or drinking is allowed in the art room.

# **Talking**

- -My art class is not a silent room. However, there are some expectations all students must follow:
  - No talking during teacher instruction, video instruction, demonstrations so on.
  - Do not interrupt a peer
  - Hold questions until called upon.
  - Students may talk freely during independent work time (school appropriate and at a reasonable volume).
  - Each class will have a Spotify music list that students are free to add songs to. Music is played during independent work

### **Moving Around the Room**

The following are the ONLY acceptable reasons to be moving around the room:

- Retrieve or put away a project
- Sharpen a pencil
- Get or put away supplies
- Clean up (end of period with teacher permission)
- Wash hands (with teacher permission)
- \* Repeatedly moving around the room socially will result in consequences at the teacher's discretion

## In Classwork / Daily Assignments

- Stay on task at all times.
- Come prepared (pencil, eraser, sketchbook).
- Students are expected to complete work at home as needed.
- For every absence student will be given one additional workday.
- Once the art fee is paid, students will get an assigned shelf to store their art kits & supplies.

#### Late Work

- Due dates can be found in Schoology and will be posted in class daily.
- All work MUST BE TURNED IN VIA SCHOOLOGY by due date or it is counted late.
- Late assignments will result in a 10-point deduction for each day it is late.
- The quality of work, student effort to come in for tutorials will also be considered in the grading process.
  - (i.e., If an assignment is one day late and the quality of work receives an 85, the grade in Skyward would be a 75).
  - (i.e., If an assignment is one day late and the quality of work receives an 85, but the student put forth effort, came to tutorials regularly and put in extra time/effort, the teacher will take that into consideration when grading and not take off late points)

### Plagiarism / Copyright Fringed Images

- Copyright Fringed images or images found from the web is UNACCEPTABLE in this class.
- Accidental or willful use of someone else's work and ideas without attribution will be penalized by a zero for a grade. And an office referral will be entered for cheating. **No exceptions.**

#### **Tutorials**

- I usually offer tutorials on as needed basis.
- Students MUST sign in on the tutorials binder so I know they are coming for AM or PM tutorials on any day.
- No PM tutorials are held on Fridays.

#### Extra Credit

- 1 may be completed once every 9 weeks
- Attend an art event or museum (must be approved by teacher). No virtual visit unless discussed with the teacher.
- Write a one-page paper on experience and provide evidence of attendance (i.e. photo, ticket stub).
