# TARDIES, ONE-WAY DOOR, 10/10 RULE

-There are 5 minutes between classes, and a student is tardy if he/she is not in the classroom when the tardy bell rings. *Tardies accumulate for all periods throughout the 9-week grading period.* 

- The GMS <u>"One Way Door"</u> policy means that once students enter a classroom, they do not leave to socialize or congregate in the hallway until the bell rings.

- Students will not be allowed to leave the classroom during the first 10 minutes after the tardy bell or during the last 10 minutes before the dismissal bell of each class. Because of this, please plan to use the restroom between classes and **NOT AFTER** you get to class.
