Math | 7th Grade | Rm 714

COURSE OVERVIEW

Seventh Grade Math builds on foundational concepts from previous years while preparing students for advanced middle school and early high school mathematics. The course focuses on deepening understanding, developing problem-solving skills, and applying math concepts to real-world situations.

EXPECTATIONS

- 1 Be On Time – Arrive before the bell with your supplies and start your warm up first five minute of class.
- 2 Be Prepared – Bring your pencils and materials every day.
- 3 Be Respectful – Listen when others are speaking, no side conversations, and no profanity.
- 4 Follow all school rules, dress code, and classroom procedures.

Re-testing:

Students with test scores below 70 are required to complete a re-teach lesson and assessment. The highest grade that may be earned on a retest is a 75.

Students are not allowed to take a test or quiz before the assigned date.

Students will need to complete the test or quiz within 5 days of their return.

Missed Work

If a student is absent, it's their responsibility to get any assignments, notes, or important information that is missed. Most work will be posted in Schoology. Students have the same number of days of their absence to turn in their work without a penalty (FBISD policy). After that time, the late work policy will apply.
