






Senior Graduation Medal Requirements Deadline for requirement completion is FRIDAY 5/1/2026

- Not eligible if club membership and/or club leadership role is revoked.
- Be in good standing with the club and sponsor
- Completed ALL Excel membership requirements for every Senior year grading term
- Must have completed and submitted a minimum of 20 hours
 of community service (YES) hours during the 25-26 school year by Friday, 5/1/2026



Submitting YES Hours






- 1.Get volunteer form filled out and signed

What are Excel Hours?



- "Elkins Hours submission"








