



# What It Means To Be A Title I School

- Title I is a federal program that provides funds to school districts and schools with high percentages of children who are disadvantaged, to support a variety of services.
- Title I is allocated to schools based on the percentage of student receiving free/reduced lunch.
- Schools with a percentage of at least 40% are eligible for a schoolwide program.
