Financial Aid – Class of 2026

- Financial information required for the 2026-27 FAFSA or TASFA application will be Tax Year 2024 Return
- FAFSA and TASFA should open October 1, 2025
 - FAFSA is for US Citizens and Permanent Residents, as well as some Visa holders.
 - TASFA is the State of Texas application for financial aid and is for students who are not Citizens or Permanent Residents
 - Both DO NOT need to be submitted...only one or the other as appropriate
