Transition Services

Transition services are provided to help students move from high school to successful work and independent living.

Through partnerships with the schools, VR provides these services to students while they are attending high school so they will be prepared when they exit. After a person leaves high school, Vocational Rehabilitation services continue to be available to them, if necessary.

-Transition services are a subset of Vocational Rehabilitation services for those individuals aged 14-22

-In most cases, the services provided to transition students fall into one of these 5 Pre-Employment Transition Services (Pre-ETS) categories:

1. Career Exploration
2. Work-Based Learning
3. Counseling on Post-Secondary Opportunities
4. Job Readiness
5. Self Advocacy

Examples of Pre-ETS Services

- Birkman Assessment/Career Exploration (online anytime)
- Vocational Adjustment Training including:
 - Disability Disclosure
 - Entering the World of Work
 - Explore the You in Work
 - Money Smart
 - Preparing for the Job Search

 - VR5060 Request for Records
- Current IEP or 504 Plan
- Birth Certificate or Passport
- Texas ID or Immigration Documentation

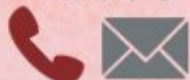
