Students will be given homework on Monday (or Tuesday, if a holiday) and it will be due Friday.

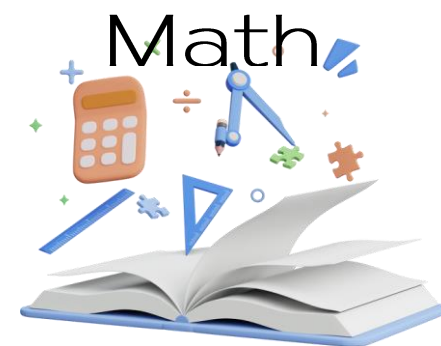
Other assignments like test reviews, videos, and corrections, may be assigned as needed.

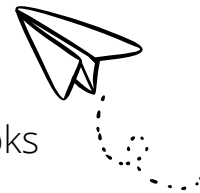
