Backpacks & Technology

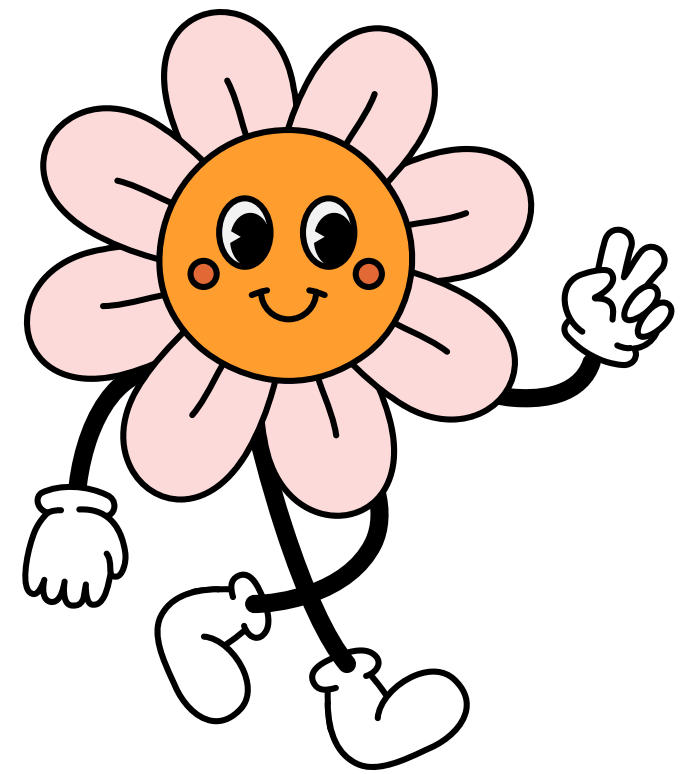

The only technology used for learning is your district-provided student laptop. You are only to use this device when permitted by your teacher. Bring your laptop fully charged each day, along with your charger.

Cell phones remain in your locker throughout the day. Keep them powered off & silenced during the school day.
