Write a brief composition describing how you might feel in this situation. Then predict what will happen to Jonas.

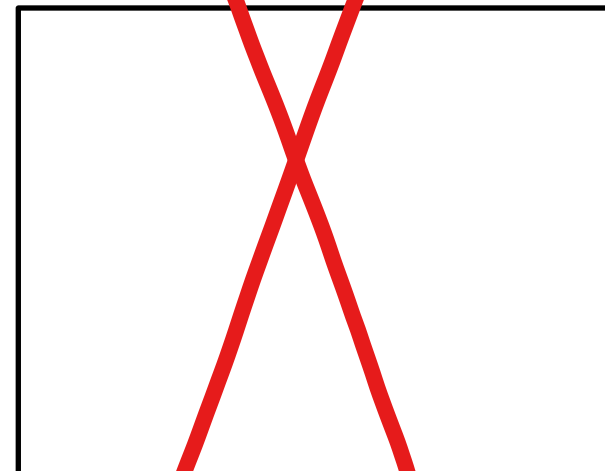

Is Gabriel going to make it? Why wasn't he released? Why did Jonas's dad fight so hard for him?

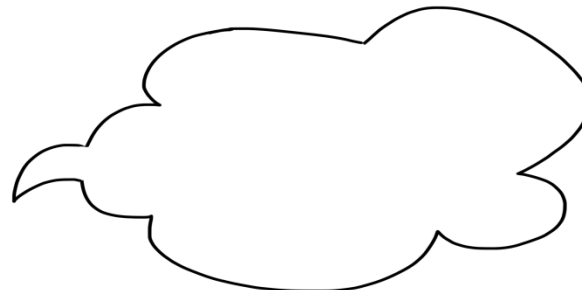
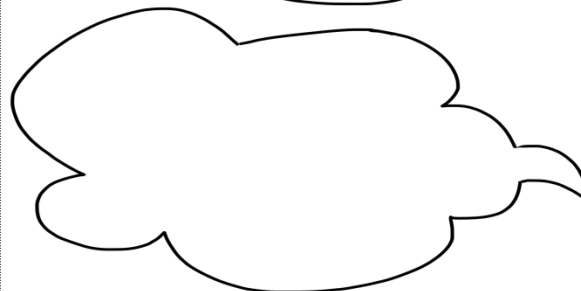
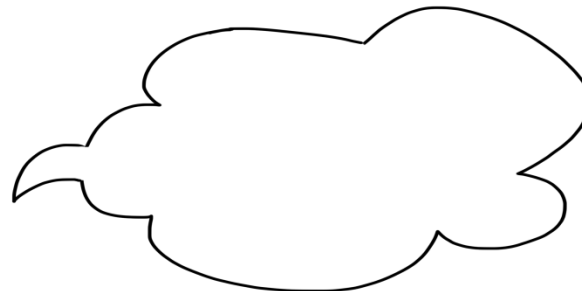
