MORE THAN TWO AUTHORS: Brown, Bob W., et al. *Skateboarding*. Knopf, 2007.

**Author of essay/story. "Title of Essay/Story." *Title of Book*, edited by, Edition (if given), Publisher, Year,
Page numbers.**

ENCYCLOPEDIAS AND REFERENCE BOOKS:

**Author of Article (if given). "Article Title." *Title of Book*, edited by, Edition if available, Volume
number for multi-volume sets, Publisher, Year, Page numbers.**

PREVIOUSLY PUBLISHED SCHOLARLY ARTICLE IN A COLLECTION:

**Author last name, first name. "Article Title." *Title of Book*, volume #, issue number, publisher, year,
page numbers. Originally published in *Original publication*, Vol. # if given, issue no if given, Year,
Page numbers.**

CRITICISM WRITTEN FOR NOVELS or SHORT STORIES FOR STUDENTS:

James, Pearl. "An Essay for *Novels for Students*." *Novels for Student*, edited by Diane Telgen, vol. 1, Gale, 1997, pp. 14-17.

DATABASES:

Author last name, first name. "Article title." Name of publication, volume #, Issue number, year of publication, page numbers from original publication. Name of specific database. URL. Date accessed starting with day and abbreviating the month with a period.

Photographer name. Title of the image. Year of publication. Title of Database. Publisher of database. URL. Date accessed starting with day of the month and abbreviating the month with a period.

Citing LITERATURE RESOURCES FROM GALE Database

Document the information for the original work in print, cite the name of the database in which the article was reproduced, *Literature Resource Center* (in italics), followed by the url and date accessed in day, month and year format followed by a period. Add original publication information.
