

GUIDELINES TO EXITING AN AAC/AP COURSE

IMPORTANT: SUCCESSFUL AAC/AP STUDENTS ARE TASK-ORIENTED, PROFICIENT READERS WHO ARE ABLE TO PRIORITIZE THEIR TIME. STUDENTS AND THEIR PARENTS SHOULD CAREFULLY CONSIDER THE TIME OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL AND THE DEDICATION REQUIRED FOR SUCCESS IN AAC/AP COURSES. EACH AAC/AP COURSE REQUIRES SEVERAL HOURS OF STUDY TIME EACH WEEK.

REQUESTS TO LEVEL DOWN WILL BE CONSIDERED **AFTER** THE FIRST **3 WEEKS** OF SCHOOL AND **ONLY** IF SPACE IS AVAILABLE IN THE NEW CLASS.

PRIOR TO REQUESTING A CHANGE IN LEVEL, THE STUDENT AND THE PARENT MUST HAVE MET WITH THE TEACHER AND PUT IN PLACE A PLAN FOR SUCCESS. IF THE TEACHER AND THE STUDENT FEEL THE PLAN HAS BEEN FOLLOWED, AND THE STUDENT HAS COMPLETED ALL ASSIGNMENTS, A REQUEST FOR A CONFERENCE TO DISCUSS THE REMOVAL MAY BE MADE.

SUCCESS IN AN AAC OR AP COURSE IS DEFINED AS HAVING A GRADE OF **75** OR ABOVE. STUDENTS MAY NOT REQUEST A LEVEL CHANGE WITH INTENT TO IMPROVE THEIR GPA.
