




Algorithm	The set of rules a social network uses to automatically decide which posts come first in your feed.		
Lurker	Someone who watches a social media feed or belongs to a social media group but does not engage with the content with a like or reply.	Virtual Reality (VR)	A simulated 3D environment that can be explored and interacted with.
Tag	A private message sent directly to a user's inbox. As opposed to a public comment on an image or on a user's timeline.	Artificial Intelligence (Al)	Software that can perform tasks that typically require human intelligence (understanding language, recognizing patterns, solving problems, learning, etc.)
		DeepFake	Fake pictures and videos that have been digitally manipulated to replace one person's likeness with that of another.



54% of teens say it would be hard to give up social media






51% visit a social media site daily 35% say they are on social media "almost constantly"


SEXTORTION

Sextortion describes a crime that happens online when an adult convinces a person who is younger than 18 to share sexual pictures or perform sexual acts on video. It is also a serious crime that occurs when someone threatens to distribute your private and sensitive material if you don't provide them images of a sexual nature, sexual favors, or money.


The average age of first exposure to porn is 12 years old¹ More than 1/3 of teens use social media to view porn¹

Predators impersonating young girls are currently targeting boys ages 14 to 17 years old²

85% of teens do not disclose instances of blackmail due to embarrassment³

Among kids who have shared their own nudes, 43% admitted they had shared them with someone they did not know in real life⁴
