What is Forensic Science?



Forensic science is the application of science and how it applies to matters of the law.

This course includes an introduction of what forensics is, crime scene analysis, evidence collection methods, different areas of trace evidence, and cause of death.

The learning strategies used will include lecture, labs, research, activities, and videos.

This course serves as your science credit and is a CTE course.

Each grading period includes a blend of major grades (tests & projects) and minor grades (labs, quizzes & homework) that are each worth 50% of your average. Your semester grade includes your grade period averages (85%) and a cumulative semester exam (15%).

All work will be assigned and posted on Schoology or in Microsoft TEAMS.
