Testing Requirements

- Does your college, university, military branch, or trade school require a standardized test?
 - SAT, ACT, ASVAB, or TSI
- Sign up to take your exams in plenty of time to meet your deadlines.
 - SAT and ACT—offered approximately once a month each
 - ASVAB--January 23rd
 - TSI—offered in the spring
- Which one should you take?
 - Determine which one is a better fit for you.
 - Plan to take at least two SAT or ACT tests



Complete Your Applications

- Plan to apply to several colleges
 - Two safety schools
 - Two target schools
 - One reach school
- Determine where you want to apply
 - Use the College Search tools on SchoolLinks
- Complete your applications
 - ApplyTexas, Common App, or college/university website
 - Application sites have different essay requirements
 - What happens after you submit? Where does your application submission go?
- Don't wait – some schools have rolling admissions!



Using Common App

- All schools inside and outside of Texas and some Texas private schools, including Rice University



Using ApplyTexas

- For all Texas public two-year and four-year colleges/universities

*Do NOT request your transcript in ApplyTexas. It must be done in SchoolLinks.



What Role Does SchoolLinks Play?

- FBISD software platform that supports students as they navigate their college and career planning process
- Access is through Clever (1Link)
- Parents can also access SL with a claim code from their student
- Your Dashboard will show you tasks you need to complete!



SchooLinks: Adding Colleges

* Do this **AFTER** you have submitted your college applications.

- Log into SchooLinks through Clever
- Click on Colleges and select College Applications
- Set up your Application Page, click Get Started
 - Enter your personal information, click Next
 - Toggle on to share your Rank Letter (ready the 1st week of October)
 - Enter your Fee Waiver eligibility (if this applies to you), click Next
 - Complete the FERPA Waiver—Click YES
- Add college to your list, and mark it as submitted. This generates a transcript request.

SchoolLinks: Next Steps

- Once your college is added, you will be able to see what is on your checklist for this school. Mark completed items.

Requesting Transcripts



- Unofficial: Skyward Portfolio or in SchoolLinks School/Records Request
- Official: Automatically requested in SchoolLinks when you add a college application
- Transcripts for a Scholarship or Coach? Go to School/Record Request under School tab and select “Send official transcript” at the top
- Dual Credit, OnRamps, etc. Transcripts?: Request directly on those schools’ websites
- What is an SRAR?
- IF you are using ApplyTexas, Do NOT request your transcript there. It must be requested through SchoolLinks.

Letters of Recommendation: Teachers

- In SchoolLinks, when you add a college to your application list, it will show you if you need a letter and how many are allowed.
- You can also request letters from people outside of AHS through this section.

TEACHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Remember to update your student profile and communicate with your teachers before adding them as a recommender on SchoolLinks.

2 Optional

Instructions from college: You may submit up to two optional letters of recommendation with your admission application. These letters may be from teachers, mentors, or people who know you well, either within or outside of your high school. The letter should be able to give additional context or information to support your admission that is not already provided in your application or other submitted documents (résumé, transcripts).

[⊕ Request Teacher Recommendation](#)

Email your teacher regarding your request and attach a resume or brag sheet.
Give them 2-3 weeks minimum to complete and submit the letters.

Letters of Recommendation: Counselors

Common App	ApplyTexas
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Goes through SchoolLinks• SL will inform you if a school requires a counselor letter	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Does NOT go through SchoolLinks• If a school requires a letter, you must request one from the counselor
<p>Email your counselor your request and attach a resume or brag sheet. Give your counselor 2-3 weeks minimum to complete and submit these documents.</p>	

What Else Can SchoolLinks Do?



Need a Resume?

- Click on your name to jump to your profile page
- Complete sections: About Me, My Story, Experience, Bragging Rights, and Academics
 - Include jobs, clubs, activities, certifications, etc.
- To create the resume, top right corner, click the resume icon
- Enter your Phone #, address, email address
- Click Download Resume. It will be in Word format and editable.

Update your Notifications!

Click on the Gear (upper right) and select Account Settings, then select Notifications. Add your personal email address to receive emails sooner. You can also add your phone # to receive SMS text messages.

Federal Application for Federal Student Aid

- Enables students to apply for:
 - Loans
 - Grants
 - Work-study programs
- Opens on December 1st!
- All seniors are **required** to complete the FAFSA or the opt out form and provide proof to Mrs. Richter through SchoolLinks
- Create your FSA ID now –you will need your social security #.
 - www.studentaid.gov-->Click create an account

Free and Reduced Lunch: More Than Meals!

- If you qualify for free and reduced lunch, your test fees and college application fees could be waived.
- How do you apply for a fee waiver?
 - Make sure you qualify for and have applied for free and reduced lunch first.
 - Contact the CCR or your counselor to obtain a fee code.

Your Action Items

1. Submit applications before adding colleges to your SL Account
2. Sign up for your SAT and/or ACT tests
3. Create your FSA ID using the QR code to the right
 - Do this before October 1st
4. Enter your phone # in SL if you want text notifications and your personal email address.
5. Ask teachers and counselors EARLY if you need a letter of recommendation
6. Check all deadlines; set reminders in your phone
7. Complete a resume in SL if you don't have one already created
