All roads lead to or from SchooLinks



- SchooLinks is the FBISD software platform that supports students as they navigate their college and career planning process
- Students access SchooLinks through Clever (1Link)
 - Parents can also access Schoolinks with a claim code from their student
- Students will use SchooLinks for
 - Managing their applications
 - Requesting their transcripts and letters of recommendation
 - Researching and applying for scholarships
 - Submitting verification for financial aid
 - Submitting enrollment decisions and requesting final transcripts



Choose schools, complete applications

- Research and identify a list of schools
 - Two safeties, two targets, one reach
- Determine best method of application
 - Common App, ApplyTexas, school website, UC app, Common Black app
- Application process can include
 - Self-reporting grades
 - Highlighting honors, achievements, volunteering and work experience
 - Reporting test scores
 - Writing essays
 - Submitting transcripts
 - Submitting rank letters
 - Submitting recommendation letters







Follow up: app confirmation/portals

Sten

- Students should receive an immediate confirmation that their application has been sent, regardless of the application platform
- Within a few weeks, students will receive an email from each school with a login to their applicant portal
- Students need to log in immediately in order to
 - Ensure that they know how to log in
 - Verify the documents that are still outstanding to complete their application
 - To continue to demonstrate interest in their school
 - Students should save all URLs in bookmark folder in their web browser


Application Checklist



Follow up: letters of recommendation

- In SchooLinks, when the student adds a college to their application list, it will show if they need one and how many are allowed
- Students have been trained on the process, which is detailed in the graphic to the right





How to Request Letters of Recommendation in Schoolinks

- Submit your applications FIRST
- Talk to your teacher face to face and share your resume
- In School inks, go to Colleges/College Applications and click on your school
- If the school requires or accepts LORs, there will be a Request Teacher Evaluation link to click (if not, don't send one)
- Choose General for most requests, and find your teacher in the search box. All FBISD employees are listed, and if your recommender is not an employee click the Add Them Manually link
- Complete the fields and click Add Recommender.

 They will receive an email with instructions
- Please allow 2-3 weeks

Apply for financial aid and scholarships

- Also known as FAFSA
- Enables students to apply for
 - Loans
 - Grants
 - Scholarships
 - Work-study programs
- Opens on October 1
- District Financial Aid Night Wednesday, September 24
- All seniors are required to complete the FAFSA, TASFA or opt-out form and provide proof to Mrs. J in Schoolinks by Friday, February 6
 - IT'S A GRADUATION REQUIREMENT!
- Parents and students should both visit studentaid.gov now and create their accounts.
 - Only one parent needs to create an account if they are married
 - Students will need their social security number before they can create their FSA ID





Extras: testing requirements and AP scores

- Does your senior's college, university, military branch or trade school require a standardized test?
 - It could be any of these: SAT, ACT, ASVAB, TSI
- Students need to sign up to take exams in plenty of time to meet deadlines
 - The SAT and ACT are offered about once a month
 - The ASVAB will be given here in November
 - The TSI will be given here in November, April and May
- Test scores are requested via College Board or ACT.org by the student. RPHS does not send them. AP scores are also sent by the student.
- Fee waivers are available
 - More information to come in a minute



Extras: transcripts

- Unofficial transcripts can be found in the student's Skyward Portfolio or in SchooLinks under School/Record Requests
- Official transcripts needed for a scholarship or a coach must be requested through SchooLinks. Go to School/Record Request and select "Send official transcript" at the top. RPHS will send it directly
- Need a dual credit or OnRamps transcript? Request directly from HCC or UT for each school you're applying to but not until you have finished all HCC or UT classes

FBISD policy: A student/parent cannot request an *official* transcript to be handed to them. They may only access *unofficial* ones through Skyward Portfolio.



Extras: fee waivers

- If your student qualifies for Free and Reduced lunch, their SAT and ACT fees, along with many college admissions fees, could be waived
- Parents should apply via SchoolCafe. They should receive a decision within five to seven days
- Eligible students will indicate their desire to use a waiver in SchooLinks and I will verify it and send to their school
