GRADING POLICY

Daily grades = 50% (warm-ups, quizzes, homework, cla work, participation)

Retests and Late Work

- Retests are allowed ONLY on major grades if the student did not have a passing grade.
- The highest grade a student can receive on the retest is a 75.
- · The student must attend at least one tutorial session before being allowed to retest, and student must complete the test before the next major assessment or end of the grading cycle.
- Students will be allowed to submit late work, but no more than three days after the assignment is due. However, for each late day, the student's grade is reduced by 10 points each day. After 5 days work will not be accepted.
- Cheating will not be tolerated, and you will receive a zero and a written up.
