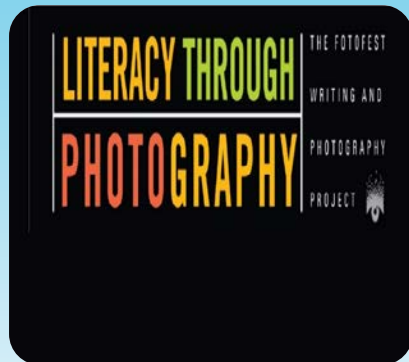
Miller Outdoor Theatre

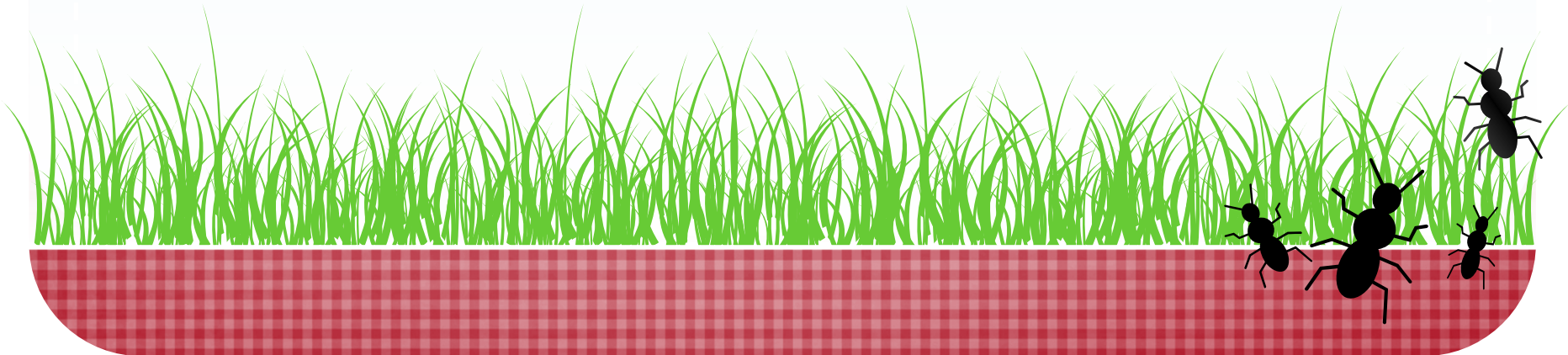
