  - Guidance Curriculum all students, Core Essential Values
  - Responsive Services intervention
  - Individual Planning managing & planning goals
  - System Support staff, parents, community

## **SERVICES PROVIDED**



- Guidance lessons during Outclass or in classrooms about:
  - Bullying prevention, anti-victimization, social media / internet safety
  - Core Essentials (character education that aligns with the FBISD profile of a graduate)
  - Small group work and one-on-one counseling with students
  - Gifted & Talented testing and referral assistance
  - Referral for outside resources: therapists, psychologists, psychiatrist
  - Consultation with parents and/or teachers

## NEEDS ASSESSMENT FOR 3<sup>RD</sup>- 5<sup>TH</sup> GRADERS



- Opportunity for students to share thoughts & feelings
- Focus small group and whole group classroom lessons
- Direct student feedback on guidance lessons

## BULLYING



- Bullying unwanted aggressive behavior through verbal, written, or electronic expression. It can occur on campus or off-campus, schoolrelated events, or a vehicle operated by the district -- including cyberbullying.
- 1. Done on purpose
- 2. One-sided
- 3. Target feels scared or intimidated by aggressor
- 4. Happens repeatedly but can ALSO happen ONE time
- \* Must meet all 4 of these criteria during investigation to qualify as bullying





## IT TAKES A TEAM!

- If your child comes home telling you he/she is being bullied, some helpful questions to ask with the 4 criteria in mind:
- What happened beforehand?
  - (To determine one-sided or mutual hurtful behavior)
- How are you feeling about that person?
  - (To determine if your child is intimated/scared or hurt/offended)
- I'm here to help. Have you told the person to stop assertively in a clear and firm way?
  - (To determine problem solving steps: ignoring, telling the other person to STOP, asking teacher for help, asking counselor for help)



- Brought to our attention via student, parent, teacher, staff member, or bus driver
- Counselor will talk with target and see what happened
- Assistant principal will continue the investigation, send parent rights home, and notify parents
- If bullying is warranted, a stay-away agreement for both parties are signed.

## GIFTED & TALENTED (GT) REFERRAL / TESTING/PROCESS



- The gifted and talented referral window is now open until Monday, Sept. 30th. Hard deadline -- There are no exceptions.
- Online referral system: https://gt.fortbendisd.com/
- Universal screener/GT testing window for 2<sup>nd</sup> grade is October 21<sup>st</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>
- Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade October 28<sup>th</sup> Nov. 8<sup>th</sup>
- Parents/Families will be asked to complete a Home Rating Scale (SIGS) in December/January
- Notification emailed out in March for all grade levels & Kindergarten GT services begin on March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025

## GIFTED & TALENTED (GT) REFERRAL / TESTING/PROCESS - CONTINUED



- **Spring:** Feb. 3<sup>rd</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>, 2025 for students who enroll in FBISD schools after the Fall window closes.
- If your child is identified for GT in one area (Math/Science or ELA/Social Studies), there will be no additional Spring testing.

# 2<sup>ND</sup> GRADE UNIVERSAL SCREENER



- 2<sup>nd</sup> graders (who are not currently identified for GT services) in Fort Bend ISD will take the Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT) during the universal screener window: October 21<sup>st</sup>-25<sup>th</sup>
- Test is untimed; self-paced and by GT administrator instruction
- All directions are read aloud to students & directions can be given in Spanish if needed.

## **Once Identified - What Happens**



GT services are provided in the core subject areas: English Language Arts, Social Studies, Math, and Science.

Students are cluster grouped with GT trained teachers.


GT Learning Plans for each student are completed to support student growth.

FBISD teachers also provide lesson differentiation, and participation in projects aligned to the Texas Performance Standards Project (TPSP).

# **GT STUDENT GROUPING**




Every campus is required to have at least 1 of these three models.

## **BIG QUESTION: HOW DO WE PREPARE OUR CHILD FOR THE TEST?**

- There is no true way to prepare for the Cognitive Abilities Test, or CogAT.
  - Be wary of companies that guarantee identification.
- Giftedness is a natural ability. They either are gifted or they aren't.
  - Only 3-5% of the population are truly gifted.
- Most of our referred students are high-achievers, not gifted.
  - Pre-AP classes in MS and HS are open to all students, not just those with needing gifted services.
