This week in Third Grade

Reading: In Reading, we will be working on understanding that informational texts are written to teach readers about real topics using facts, explanations, and evidence. They will also be able to recognize common features that help readers locate and understand information.

Writing: In Writing students will begin their new unit on informational writing. Students will begin understanding the characteristics of informational writing.

Math: We are learning to classify and sort 2-D and 3D figures so that we can describe relationships between their attributes.

Social Studies: Students will be learning how cultural celebrations help people remember important people or events from their culture.

Science: We are learning how to use models to explain patterns of the orbits of the moon and Earth in relation to the sun.

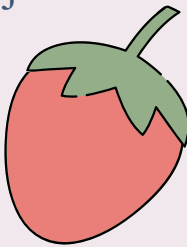
