


Classroom News

Week of March 2nd thru 6th



This week in Third Grade

Reading: In Reading, students will learn the purpose and characteristics of argumentative text. Students will learn how to identify the claim, intended audience, and notice how the author uses facts to support arguments. At the end of the concept, students will retell argumentative text.

Writing: In Writing, students are working toward writing their own argumentative essays in which they choose a claim they want to share with their reader as their purpose. Students will support their claim with arguments that are based on facts rather than opinions. Students will ensure their purpose is achieved throughout the writing process by reflecting on the decisions they made as a writer.

Math: In Math, students have been representing and solving one-and two-step word problems with different operations by using different strategies. They have been representing problems using array, strip diagrams and equations.

Social Studies: In Social Studies, students understand how the present is shaped by the past. In the first two concepts, students will learn about communities in the past with an emphasis on the people who have created or changed communities.


Science: In Science, students will learn how to collect and analyze data to explain how natural resources are important and can be managed.
