What We're Learning This Week

Reading: Readers pay attention to the way a poem looks. They use white space, line breaks, and fonts to read the poem the way the poet intended.

Writing: Poets write poems that use sensory details so the reader can experience their poems in a special way.

Social Studies: Students will learn about the major landforms and bodies of water in order to better understand the world.

Math: Students will write and solve one-step word problems involving addition or subtraction using data represented within pictographs and bar graphs with intervals of one.
