What We're Learning This Week

Reading: Readers are immersed into the informational genre and notice the structure.

Writing: Writers choose an informational topic and write a central idea.

Social Studies: Students will learn about cultural celebrations to understand why they are important to people.

Math: Students will learn to represent numbers up to 1,200 a variety of ways so they can use place value understandings to compare, order, add, and subtract numbers.

Science: Students will investigate and describe how wind and water move soil and rock particles across the Earth's surface such as wind blowing sand into dunes on a beach or a river carrying rocks as it flows.
