





Step 1: Submitted Application (GoApplyTexas, Common App, Coalition, College Website)

Application Essays*

Application Fees (or Fee Waiver)

Step 2: Transcript (via requested Naviance)

Step 3: Test Scores (ACT/SAT)

Step 4: Teacher Letters of Recommendation*

Step 5: Resume & other "recommended" or "optional documents"*

Step 6: Keep track of applications on College portals

- 3 safe schools
- 3 target schools

- Deadlines
- Applications
- Requirements

Deadlines

- Early Action/Priority
- Dearly Decision
- Regular Decision
- Rolling Admissions
- MUST Complete ALL aspects of the application by this deadline

Essays

- Start early - 3 peer reviews
- Submit via application
- *Not always required

Application Fee

- Pay application at the time of applying
- Fee Waivers for students on free and reduced lunch

Submitting

- SUBMIT
- Do not let an application "sit"

Step 2: Transcripts

Official Request

- Request **AFTER** submitting applications
- ALL request are made in Naviance
- Click on "Colleges I'm Applying to" to request

Unofficial Request

- Download from Skyward under Portfolio
- Self Reported Academic Record
- Scholarships

Common App

- Match Common App to Naviance
- Input Official Request
- *Email your counselor*
- Counselor Submits

ApplyTexas / Other

- Input Official Request
- "Direct to the Institution
- Registrar Sends

Step 3: Test Scores

Types of College Admissions Testing

- SAT: collegeboard.org
- ACT: actstudent.org

College Placement Testing

- TSI: accuplacer.org

Test Optional

- College does NOT require a test score for admissions

Sending Scores

- Send through the official testing website
- \$12 per score sent
- Minimum of 2 weeks to send and receive scores
- Schools will ONLY look at your highest score received

TSI Exemptions

- ACT Exemption Standards
 - Composite: 23
 - English: 19 (minimum)
 - Math: 19 (minimum)
- SAT Exemption Standards
 - Evidence Based Reading & Writing: 480 (minimum)
 - Math: 530 (minimum)
 - NO COMBINATION SCORE



Step 4: Letter of Recommendations

Step One

- Research the letter of recommendation requirements for each college or university you are applying to.

Step Four

- Submit your admissions application for the university. Add the college to the Colleges I am Apply To list in Naviance.

Step Two

- Speak with the teacher **IN PERSON** no less than three weeks before the deadline **NEEDED** regarding the letter of recommendation. Provide the teacher with a copy of your resume.

Step Five

- Officially submit the request in Naviance.

Step Three

- Follow up with the teacher via email regarding the request. Be sure to thank the teacher!

- Not a DHS Teacher?
- Must follow University guidelines for submitting recommendation letters
- Contact Admission Rep
- Mail in letter of recommendation
- Submit via University portal

- Resume
- Supplemental Essays
- School Profile/Report
- Counselor Recommendation
- AP Test Scores
- Writing Samples
- Portfolio (Art)
- Audition (Performing Arts)
- Interview
- College Campus Visit



Step 6: Keep Track

University Portal

- After submitting your application, each college will provide you with a "university login"
- Create your account
- Keep track of required admissions items
- YOU WILL NOT BE REVIEWED UNTIL YOU HAVE A COMPLETE APPLICATION


Automatic Admissions in Texas

- Based on GPA/Rank & Test Scores
- Top 10% accepted to all PUBLIC universities in Texas (Top 6% for UT Austin)
- Auto-admit to the College NOT the major



Holistic Review Process

- Students not accepted based on Top 10 or academically, will have their entire application reviewed by the university. (Usually done by the admissions officers for our region)
- This is where the student's essay, resume, grades, activities, and letters of recommendation really come into play!
- Recommend that students who fall into the holistic review process request an interview with the Admissions Officer and/or the Director of Admissions.



Step 7: Financial Aid & Scholarships

FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

- Open October 1
- Grants, Student Loans, Scholarships
- Available to US Citizens & Permanent Residents
- Need Based
- Apply for the 2023-2024 FAFSA
- Use the 2021 Tax return

Scholarships

- University Scholarships
 - Application either in Apply Texas or through the university's website
 - Merit based
 - Need based
- Third Party Scholarships
 - Mrs. Warren's emails
 - List in Naviance
 - E-scholarships
 - Many more sites

Other

- TASFA
 - Texas Application for State Financial Aid
 - Available ONLY for DACA, Non-US Citizens
- CSS Profile
 - Mainly for private schools
 - Managed by the College Board
 - Has a fee for submitting application (fee waiver available)






