SELECT A CHALLENGE

OPTION 1:

Cool Leaf Structures - Have you ever thought about designing and building a structure using leaves? To get started, connect with nature by taking a nature walk. During your nature walk gather a collection of fallen leaves. Using the leaves you collected and household items, create a structure of your choice that is greater than six inches tall.

OPTION 2:

Creative Imaginations - How creative are you? This is your opportunity to be innovative! Using household/recycled items, build a device that can do three different creative things. Develop a plan, draw a model, and use your imagination and creativity to build your device.

OPTION 3:

Spreading Kindness (**15 Day Challenge**)- What can you do to spread kindness? Creating a culture of kindness is important and it makes a difference. Also, spreading kindness is transferable - kindness can spread to others through your initial actions. With your family, friends, and/or teachers, commit to spreading random acts of kindness for fifteen days. Document (chart) your random acts of kindness to share and reflect on how it impacted you!
