3.6.3 Requirements for a Student to Be Considered Present for FSP (Funding) Purposes –2018-19 SAAH

- 1. Is enrolled/attending off-campus **dual credit program** courses and is not on campus.
- 2. Is participating in an **off-campus work-based learning** opportunity.
- 3. Is enrolled **full-time** in **TxVSN** courses.
- 4. Is participating in an **activity** that is approved by your local school board and is under the direction of a district professional staff member, an adjunct staff member, or a para
- 5. Is participating, with local school board approval, in a short-term (for example, 5-day) class that is provided by the Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired (TSBVI) or the Texas School for the Deaf (TSD) at a location other than the student's campus.
- Is participating in a mentorship approved by district personnel to serve as one or more of the advanced measures needed to complete the Distinguished Achievement Program (DAP) outlined in 19 TAC Chapter 74.
- 7. misses school for **observing district-approved religious holy days**, including traveling.
- 8. Is in grades 6 through 12 and misses school for the purpose of sounding "Taps" at a military honors funeral held in Texas for a deceased veteran.
- 9. misses school for the purpose of attending a required **court appearance**, including traveling for that purpose.
- Is in the conservatorship of the DFPS and misses school to participate in an activity ordered by a court or attend an activity under a service plan (Texas Family Code, Ch. 263, Subch. B).
- 11. Misses school for the purpose of serving as a student **early voting clerk**, if your school district has a policy allowing for this type of excused absence, or misses school for the purpose of serving as an election clerk or student election clerk.
- 12. Misses school for the purpose of appearing at a governmental office to complete paperwork required in connection with the student's application for US citizenship, including traveling for that purpose.
- 13. Misses school for the purpose of taking part in the student's own or parent's or guardian's **US naturalization** oath ceremony, including traveling for that purpose.
- 14. Is temporarily absent because of a documented, face-to-face appointment for the student or the student's child that is with a **health care professional** licensed, certified, or registered by an appropriate agency of the State of Texas to practice in the United States.
- 15. Is in his or her junior or senior year of high school and misses school for the purpose of **visiting an institution of higher education**.
- 16. Is absent to visit with a parent, stepparent, or legal guardian who is an active duty member of the uniformed services and has been called to duty for, is on leave from, or is immediately returned from continuous deployment of at least four months outside the locality where the parent, stepparent, or guardian regularly resides.
- 17. Is 17 years of age or older and **pursuing enlistment** in a branch of the United States Armed Services or the National Guard.
