JUSTICE helps kids see the bigger picture — that fairness applies not only at home and school, but also in our communities and the world. Kids naturally care about right and wrong, and they often have a strong sense of empathy. This month (November 3-14) students who were referred for GT testing will be assessed during the school day.


Please help your child prepare with a good night's sleep, a healthy breakfast, and a calm mindset. There is no need to "study" as this is an assessment of the student's natural ability.
