

Guidelines for Grade 6 Math 2022-2023

1. **Supplies** required **daily** in class:

Personal Supplies

- 4 - 1 subject spirals (1 for each grading Term)
- Folder (for homework/graded work)
- #2 Pencils
- Scissors
- Highlighters
- Pencil Sharpener
- Tape or Glue Sticks
- Markers or colored pencils
- Dry erase markers (no yellow; for personal use)

Classroom Supplies

- 1 – package of notebook paper to be collected for classroom (graph paper optional)

2. The **classroom norms** are:

- Be respectful at all times.
- Be prepared. (***Having all materials needed for class including homework***)
- Be on time.

3. **Quizzes/checkpoints** will be given to check for student comprehension and counted as daily grades throughout each nine week grading period. Quizzes can be used to help review for tests.

4. **Math work** is to be ***neat*** and in ***pencil***. This allows for neater error corrections as problems are worked. Students **must show their work/process** for all assignments. ***Not showing work can lead to point penalties.***

5. **Late Work/Make-Up Work/Re-Testing Policies:** See Student Handbook for policies.

- 1 day late (-10)
- 2 days late (-20)
- 3 days late (-30)
- After 5 days - highest grade possible is a 50.

6. **Worksheets:** If a student loses his/her homework worksheet, they can call a friend and have it copied or access Schoology lesson folder if provided.

7. **Tutoring Day** for Math is **THURSDAY** morning starting at **8:20 am**. Students do not need a pass but must arrive in the classroom by **8:25 am**.

8. **Schoology:** Schoology will be used for communication, calendaring, assignment posting, class notes, review boards, and many other things.

We will be sending home a signature sheet to verify completion of this request. This will help us to work as a team to support your child’s success in math.
