# BE RESPECTFUL

- **WHAT IS RESPECT??**
- **IT'S THE SENSE OF WORTH OR PERSONAL VALUE THAT YOU ATTACH TO SOMEONE**
- **IT'S THE OVERALL EVALUATION YOU GIVE SOMEONE BASED ON MANY FACTORS**
- **SELF RESPECT IS YOUR VIEW OF HOW YOU'RE LIVING YOUR LIFE**

# BE RESPONSIBLE

## Attendance

Everyone starts fresh in August!

Policy: to receive credit or a final grade in any class, you must attend at least 90% of the days the class is offered. This applies per class, per semester.

When you are absent from school – upon arrival or within five days of returning to school – you must bring a note signed by your parent/guardian that details the reason for your absence.



# BE RESPONSIBLE

Leaving school early:

You must bring a signed note from a parent or guardian and submit it to the attendance office in the morning.

***REMEMBER*** – You **MUST** sign out with attendance any time you leave. If you do not, your absence will be unexcused.



# BE RESPONSIBLE

## Be Present.

- Plan your day to arrive at school ON TIME.
- Students arriving late must sign in at the attendance office.
- Get to each class ON TIME.
- If you are more than 20 minutes late, you WILL be counted absent for that class – these are usually UNEXCUSED absences.
- FBISD Truancy Policy: any unexcused absence – for ANY period - will be considered truancy.
- Truancy offenses can be referred to the truancy court of Fort Bend County.
- STAY IN SCHOOL --- STAY OUT OF COURT!!!





# BE RESPONSIBLE

## Be mindful. Be considerate.

Cell phones are allowed during passing periods and lunches in all common areas both before and after school.

Responsible cell phone usage in your classes:

- Cell phone usage should be restricted to educational purposes as instructed by your teacher.
- When not in use, cell phones should be on silent.
- Secure your phone. Stolen phones are often not recovered. Administrators and campus police are NOT obligated to investigate.

# BE RESPONSIBLE

## Be a good digital citizen.

- Protect your online reputation.
- Social media is searchable and easily retrievable! If you click “Send”, “Share”, “Tweet” or “Post”, assume that your message/picture/video is going to be out there FOREVER!!!
- It can be altered after the fact by someone else.
- Don't post anything you wouldn't want your parents, grandparents, teachers, college admissions counselors or future employers to see.
- College admissions offices, college coaches and employers DO search social media when determining whom they will take and whom they WON'T!

# BE RESPONSIBLE

## Lunch

Travis is a CLOSED campus. Students are not allowed to leave for lunch.

If your parents deliver you a lunch – it **MUST** be dropped off in the front office. To pick it up – you **MUST** have your ID.

# BE SAFE

## Expectations in Hallways

- Please walk on the right side of the hallways as much as possible.
- Please walk on the right side of the stairwells as well!
- PLEASE WALK AND TALK - students are not allowed to congregate in the hallways in between classes.
- Make sure your student ID is visible at all times (once you get it)!
- DO NOT open exterior doors for anyone!
- All visitors should enter the building via the front office.
- It takes ALL of us to make it safe for ALL of us!



# BE SAFE

## Safe behavior means AVOIDING:

- Harassment
- Assaults/ Fighting
- Threats – online/in-person
- Bullying/cyberbullying
- Alcohol, drugs, weapons, tobacco, vapes
- Theft of ANYTHING

If you are disciplined and must be removed, it's over an hour bus ride to alternative school (Ferndell Henry Center for Learning)!



# BE SAFE

## Vaping

- Vaping of any kind is against school policy!
- Students who are caught vaping or in possession of any type of vape will face disciplinary consequences.
- Take care of your health and make the right choice to BE SAFE!



# BE SAFE

## WE ARE A CLOSED CAMPUS

- All students must remain on campus once they arrive! Even before school! No walking to Timewise or the donut shop!
- Students may not leave during lunches – failure to comply could result in loss of parking privileges or other disciplinary consequences.
- No DoorDash, Uber Eats or other food deliveries.
- You may not go to the parking lot during the school day without a parking lot pass! You must get a parking lot pass from Ms. Humber-White in A116! These will be given for URGENT issues only!

# BE SAFE

## Canine Searches

- Lockers may be inspected by trained dogs at any time.
- Vehicles parked anywhere on school property may be inspected by trained dogs at any time.
- Classrooms and other common areas may be inspected by trained dogs at any time when students are not present. Students may be asked to exit a room and leave personal property in the room for a canine search.
- If contraband *of any kind* is found, the possessing student shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct. If other students are involved, disciplinary action can also be taken.
