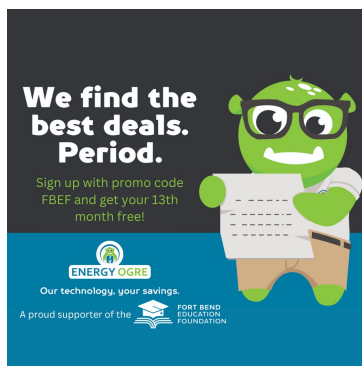
Save the Date – March 4 for our 2023 Gala

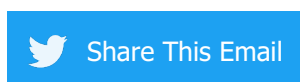

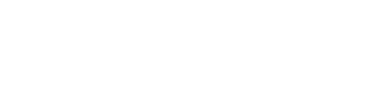
