Dear Parent/Guardian and Candidate,

We are delighted that your dancer has shown an interest in auditioning for the Clements High School Dance Teams for the 2026-2027 school year. **REMINDER:** incoming 9th graders are eligible to be considered for JV and Varsity. As a parent/guardian of a prospective Dance Team member, you should be fully aware of the audition procedures and requirements for dance team membership. You and your dancer must also realize the commitment and dedication required for all members once they have been selected for the Dance Team.

NEW for this coming school year:

The JV dance team at Clements High School enters an exciting new chapter with a name change for the Junior Varsity Dance Team from Twinkles to JV Stars. *Founded in the 2012–2013 school year by Michelle Barth with 19 members, the Twinkles quickly established a strong legacy through performances at pep rallies, halftime appearances alongside the Stars, contests, and Spring Shows. While the name evolves, the tradition, spirit, and impact of the Twinkles will continue to shine through the JV Stars for years to come!*

While a member of the Dance Team, your dancer will receive the best character training possible, experiencing good times, glory and recognition, along with gaining dependability, responsibility, self-discipline and life-long memories. Being a member of an organization such as Dance Team has been the highlight of many dancers' high school experience and provided them with an important opportunity for self-development. Success throughout the year, especially at team competitions, is a goal not only for us as Directors, but we hope for all dancers too. With that comes commitment to training, willingness to understand and trust the process through the highs and lows that come along the journey of competitive training. During the team audition, judges are looking for mastery of skills *but also* will consider those dancers that show potential and desire to work towards self-improvement! With that, if you are selected for either JV Stars or Stars and happen to receive a Probationary Contract, it will outline the expectations for you to uphold over the summer before we see you again for the new school year.

The following packet will familiarize you with the audition process and general information concerning Dance Team that should be understood *before* auditions. Being selected as a Dance Team member is not only an outstanding achievement and a great honor; it is a decision that is encouraged to be discussed between you and your dancer as the audition process can be demanding both physically and emotionally, so parental/guardian support is essential.

CURRENT MEMBERS AUDITIONING: *Team auditions do take place before Team Banquet again this year. We want this special annual event to be enjoyable for all those that are attending. In the event that results are not what one expected or wanted we are giving the option for individual results to be held until after Banquet. **If you would like your dancer's results to be held, then please email both directors and we can make this accommodation for your dancer. If we do not receive an email by April 30th, we will release results as normal on May 5th.***

In this packet you will find an outline of the audition process as well as general CHS Dance Team information.

Current Clements students, make your way to the Dance Room when 7th period is dismissed. We are on the second floor, above the Girl's Gym, between the Math hallways and the end of the Foreign Language rooms – directly across from Ms. Flores' room.

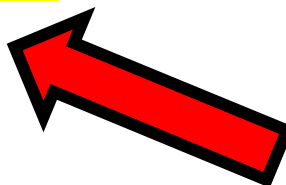
For any middle school students and non-Clements/FBISD students auditioning, please arrive at the BAND HALL DOORS. A Stars officer will be waiting at the doors to greet you and escort you to the dance room. This part of the building is accessible via the staff parking lot. You will see a tall metal tower in this lot, entering on the end where the softball field is located.

- ❖ Dancers will be assigned an audition number upon arrival **on** audition day.
- ❖ Dancers will be warmed up and stretched. **The routine will be taught on mock audition day.**
 - *A video of the audition routine will be posted on the Audition Candidate Band page prior to the mock audition. It is strongly encouraged but not required for Dance Team candidates to begin to familiarize themselves with the audition routine prior to the audition day.*
- ❖ Skills in the audition process will include *but not limited to*:
 - Right, Left and Center Splits
 - Pirouettes, Coupe Turns
 - Turning jumps
 - Jetés (*traveling and stationary*)
- ❖ All dancers will perform the audition routine in front of a panel of **5 judges**, which includes both Directors.
- ❖ There is no set number of dancers for either the JV or the Varsity Dance Teams.

If you are selected for either of the teams, dancers **and** a parent/guardian will be required to attend the NEW TEAM MEETING. **Tuesday, May 19th at 6:00pm in the CHS Library** *Membership subject to dismissal for failure to attend.*



Examples OF COSTS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

The first year on the dance team you will be required to purchase: *a team spirit jersey shirt, backpack (NEW: Team Logo backpacks!), garment bag (Stars), team bow and a handful of other various items which change year to year depending on vendor availability.* You will order via Google form & submit full payment on due date listed below. **Approx cost: \$250 - \$600**

Daily rehearsal clothing will be ALL BLACK - dancers may choose at their discretion what that may be: leotard, sports bra & shorts, leggings and a solid black tank, etc. Items must be FITTED and SOLID BLACK. Most dancers already have items such as these on hand. **Approx cost: \$0 - \$200**

Dance Team Booster Club Cost*

The Booster Club Board members and directors agreed upon an increase in booster fees due to inflation and rising costs. The last increase was five years ago. Annual Membership Costs differ depending on membership.

*Membership dues cover a variety of items throughout the year including but not limited to: all team Shirts, master classes, choreography, spirit items, etc.

Booster Club Fees will be due before the last day of school. Dates will be posted via Band group. Other fees such as supplies and camp fees will be due at various times. Details on due dates will be shared at the first mandatory team meeting in May after auditions. *Monthly payment plans may be set up on a case-by-case basis via parent/guardian email to both Directors. Information such as this remains confidential.*

Things TO NOTE

Returning or potential new member, EVERYONE can benefit from reading through this section!

- ❖ If you are selected for either team, your name will be submitted to the Counselors - you do not need to contact your counselor about your schedule.
- ❖ On football game days:
 - **ALL Stars** are required to stay after school for Away **NON-FBISD Stadium** Game Day performance preparations.
 - **Game Day Meals** with the Band will be offered for Away Non-FBISD Stadium Games ONLY and are *optional* to sign up. Details to be shared.
 - Any THURS football games results in no Friday rehearsal for Stars.
- ❖ JV Stars will attend and perform at *least* one Varsity football games alongside Stars.
 - If it is a Non-FBISD Stadium game they are attending, the above applies to them.
- ❖ FBISD Transportation will go as follows *unless otherwise changed by FBISD*:
 - **Transportation will be provided to all NON-FBISD Stadium games.**
 - For all FBISD Stadium games (Mercer or Hall), members are responsible for providing their ride to/from the game. Carpooling is strongly encouraged.

Other IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- ❖ FBISD operates on a rotation system for Fine Arts groups participating in the **Fort Bend County Fair Parade** and **this is NOT our year to participate!**
- ❖ **JV Stars and Stars Dance Officers** is 5th period and **Varsity Stars** is 7th period.
 - Reminder about **class time vs rehearsal time...**
 - 5TH and 7th period are considered class time and **not** rehearsal time. Yes, we use class time to rehearse but that is part of the regular school day that is time set by the state that students must be in the classroom setting for instruction.
 - UIL rules state that between the beginning of instruction on Mondays (7:30am) and the end of instruction on Fridays (2:50pm). Teams cannot rehearse more than 8 hours/week.
 - *During our most lengthy rehearsal time, Contest Season, we still do not exceed the limit of 8 hours/week as Friday after 2:50 doesn't count towards the UIL rule since a regular instructional day doesn't follow it.*
 - **NO REGULARLY SCHEDULED Stars Team rehearsal on Mondays.**
 - This is the day we expect everyone to schedule their appointments, tutorials, etc. We of course understand that on occasion, this is unavoidable.
 - Dependent upon special circumstances, we may have to schedule a Monday rehearsal sparingly. Details for those days will be communicated well in advance.
 - Please also note: *on occasion, times will be adjusted on a case-by-case basis.*
- ❖ There are after school rehearsals for **Stars**.
 - **Football Season**
 - Tuesdays – Fridays until 4:00pm
 - Team is DISMISSED on game days at 2:50 WHEN we play at a FBISD stadium (Mercer or Hall).
 - Team will STAY on campus when we play at a NON-FBISD stadium (ex: Traylor Stadium in LCISD) and eat Game Day Meal. Run thru with the band, load the bus and go!
 - If we have a THURS game – there will be no rehearsal on Friday.
 - **Contest Season** ***This will be split up between non-competing weeks and competing weeks.*** *Non-competing weeks, Stars will rehearse as follows:*
 - Tuesdays – Fridays: 2:50pm – 4:00pm***Competing weeks, Stars will rehearse as follows:***
 - Tuesdays – Fridays: 2:50 – 4:30pm
 - **Spring Show Season** ***(begins after spring break)***
 - Mondays and Fridays: dismissed at 2:50pm
 - Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays: dismissed at 3:30pm
 - The **WEEK OF** Spring Show, rehearsal M – F. Times TBA on Band calendar.
- ❖ **JV Stars** for most of the year do not have rehearsal outside of school time. You will have rehearsal for the football game(s) you are attending. Also, as we approach contest season, morning and/or after school rehearsal will be scheduled to prepare the team for competitions.

Summer Camp DETAILS

Stars Summer Camp is *****MANDATORY**

Monday, August 3rd through Friday, August 7th from 9:00am – 3:30pm

Other important dates to note:

- Ranger Camp is INCREDIBLY early this year for an unknown reason. It will be on **Thursday, July 23rd**. Dance Officers will PERFORM at this event. For any Stars IN TOWN, we would love for you to join us 😊 More details to come!
- Meet The Rangers is on **Saturday, August 22nd**. Call time and other details TBA. JV Stars will join Stars at this event!

*****Dancers who are not present for any portion of Summer Team Camp are at risk of losing their performance spot for football and contest season.** *Dancers who are absent without either Director having prior knowledge, will receive a consequence from the Directors. IF something comes up, as soon as you are aware of a scheduling conflict, please reach out to us. We are happy to help find compromises. Finding out about an absence the evening before or morning of is not helpful. We of course understand some circumstances happen without notice. Emergencies are always taken seriously and without consequences.*

Additional AUDITION DETAILS

For the audition, candidates must wear the following:

- + Solid black *fitted* dance clothing, such as leggings, hot shorts, a workout tank top or leotard.
- + Hair in a neat, low pony with any bangs secured away from your face.
- + Light make-up, performance lipstick = red/deep burgundy.
- + Candidates may audition either: barefoot, in tan jazz shoes or Twyla (half-sole) shoes.
- + You will need to bring at least four (4) safety pins for you to pin your number to your clothing. Safety pins will not be provided on audition day.

IMPORTANT - In your application, you will be asked to select which team you are wanting to be considered for, if you select ONLY Stars or ONLY JV Stars, you can only be placed on the team you've selected. If judges do not place you on that team based off your audition, you will not be placed on the other team since you didn't specify that you're willing to be on either team.
