

## VISITORS WELCOME

Visitors are welcome at all campuses and district facilities.



## CLEANING & DISINFECTING MEASURES

Cleaning and disinfecting will continue for the prevention of any infectious diseases in all FBISD schools and facilities. The district uses disinfectants that reduce the spread of respiratory illness.



# MONITORING **MEASURES**

Ongoing monitoring of cases and safety practices are in place and additional mitigation procedures will be employed as needed.



### RESPIRATORY ILLNESS

#### **RETURN**

Individuals who test positive for respiratory illness (i.e. COVID-19, Flu, RSV, etc.) may return to school/work when they have improvement of symptoms, and the individual has been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications.



#### MASKS OPTIONAL

Masks are optional at all FBISD campuses and facilities. FBISD supports the personal choice of all students, staff, and visitors whether or not to wear a mask.
