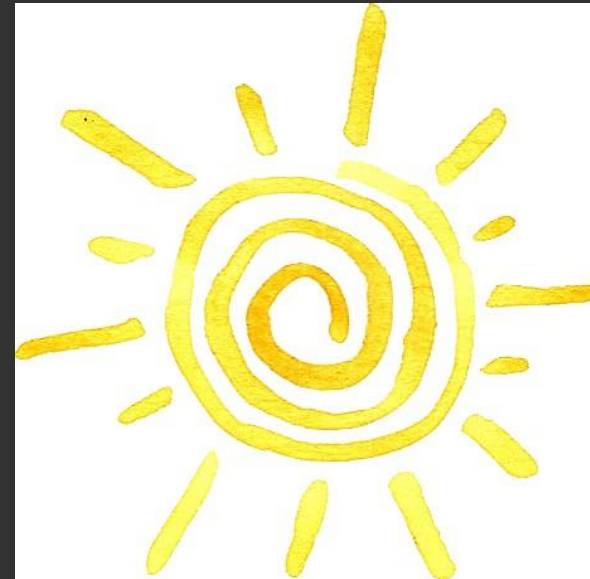

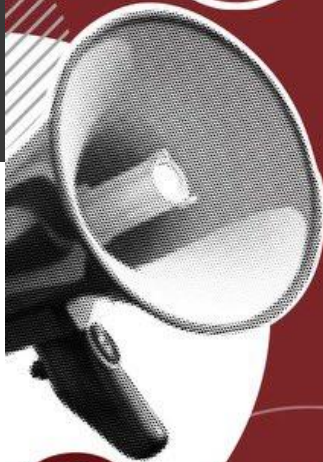

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT!

In order to support student learning, the cell phone expectation for the 2024-2025 school year is that all students will silence their cell phones and place them in their backpacks during all instructional time. 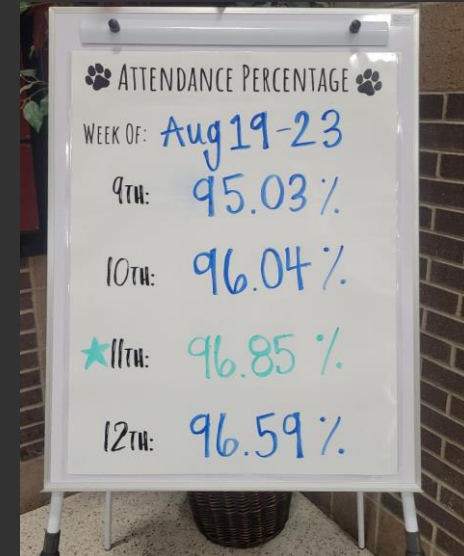
UNEXCUSED ABSENCES

If I forget my laptop, it is my responsibility to check one out prior to 1st period & return it at the end of the day.



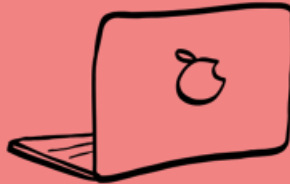
05.

I will only use my laptop for school related activities.

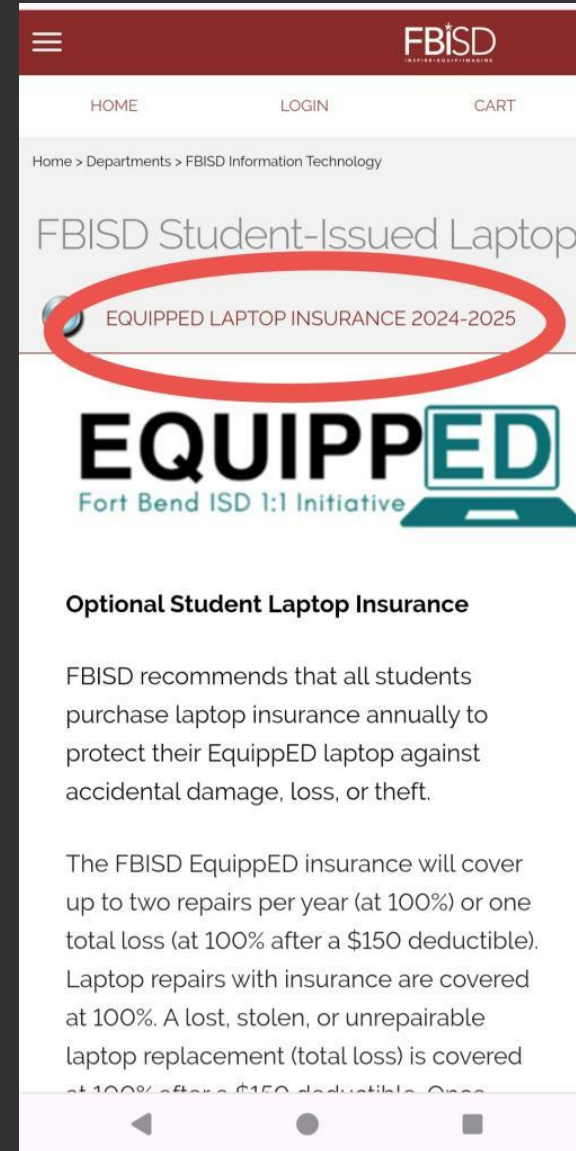


08.



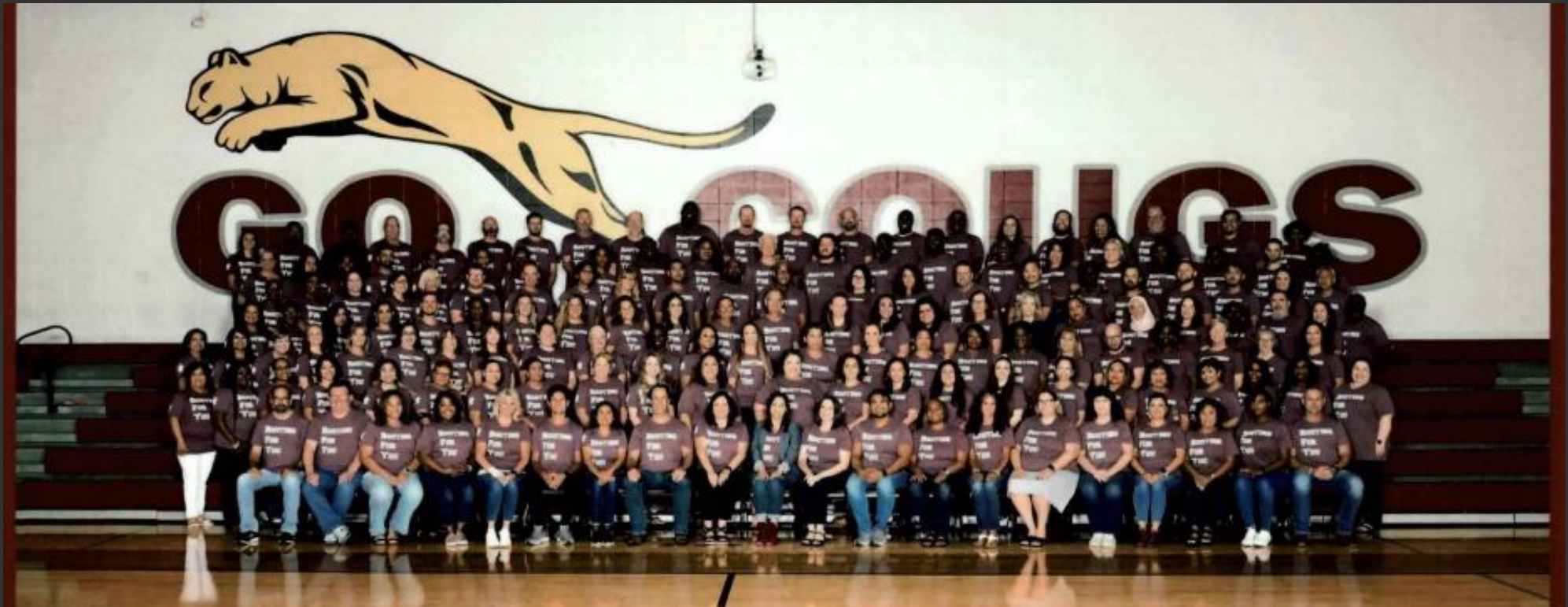
