




OUR MISSION

A MODEL THAT WORKS



Research shows that students who enter college with credit from a dual credit course are two times more likely to graduate in four years than students entering without credit.

COLLEGE STANDARDS

Developed by The University of Texas at Austin Faculty Modeled after existing residential University courses

OnRamps Instructors are taught classroom practices that stimulate active engagement, rich discussion, and learning retention
Students are taught to take ownership of their learning and persist through academic challenges

REDUCING EARLY COLLEGE ACCESS BARRIERS

Enrollment Requirements

No application or test required; students only need to complete prerequisite high school courses to enroll

Accommodations (IDA, 504)

Individualized and based on the student's needs for both the high school and college courses





REDUCING BARRIERS

TSI Exemption via OnRamps

Earned and accepted college course credit in certain
OnRamps courses may exempt students from taking the TSI
Assessment





BENEFITS TO STUDENTS

- ✓ Develop college-level skills in time management, collaboration, studying strategies, and data literacy, among others.
- ✓ Become more creative and persistent problem-solvers.
- ✓ Make connections between course concepts and real-world experiences.
- ✓ Gain expertise in current tools and software used in today's workplace.
- ✓ Develop agency and learn how to advocate for solutions and themselves.



COLLEGE CREDIT EARNED

OnRamps awarded over 80,000 semester credit hours in 2021-2022, and 92% of eligible students earned college credit.



ONRAMPS TRANSFERABILITY

- ✓ College credits earned through OnRamps courses are transferable to public and private colleges in Texas and out-of-state institutions.
- ✓ Most OnRamps courses fulfill core curriculum requirements. Public colleges in Texas require 42 hours of core curriculum courses for all students pursuing an undergraduate degree.
- ✓ Students who earn and accept OnRamps credit will have an official university transcript.



SUPPORTING STUDENT TRANSFERABILITY

We provide resources to OnRamps students when they are choosing to accept or decline their credit.

We encourage them to answer these questions for each institution they are interested in attending:

- 1. How does it **transfer**?
- 2. How does it count towards my degree plan?
- 3. How will it affect my GPA?


Where to find credit transfer information:


