Dear Titan Students and Parents,

Last week we had a good turnout for Orientation. We would like to thank our 8<sup>th</sup> grade WEB leaders for helping orient our newest Titans! For those families that were unable to attend, we will do an abbreviated **Make-Up Orientation** (orientation "lite") in a come-and-go format this **Thursday, August 17<sup>th</sup>, from 6:00 until 8:00 PM**. Students will be able to get their locker and locker combination and have an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the campus. It might be a good chance to bring some of your supplies to school, and place them in your locker (although they will not be needed until later). 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys wishing to play football may also pick up their equipment that evening, as well (see section about football below for details).

Below is some helpful information for you as we head toward the start of the school year. **Please take note that this year FBISD is working to go "paperless" when it comes to completion of the usual first-day forms.** Your child will come home with only one small packet on the first day, and there is nothing to return to school. To find out more and to start filling out your forms online, please read this <u>Update Your Student's Information</u> flyer. Please give your child permission to use computers at school and to be able to take surveys so that their voice is heard.

Important Note: If you have been informed or if you know that you have documentation that must be turned in (not limited to but including outstanding immunizations, renewals of dual-residency and/or power of attorney, etc.), please bring this paperwork to SLMS by Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup>, at Noon. This is our cut-off time so that staff may complete their readiness tasks for the first day of school. Students who have outstanding items past noon on Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup>, risk being unable to attend classes on the first day of school.

- Building Hours for Students: 8:20 to 4:20. Students should not arrive before 8:15 AM, due to supervision reasons
- Parents should observe all traffic signage along Seventh Street, as well as to be patient
- Bike riders should utilize the bike rack near the main entrance off of Seventh Street; walk bikes once arriving on campus
- Car riders should <u>only</u> use the front circle drive by the main entrance off Seventh Street; there are no left turns permitted from the front circle drive back onto Seventh Street
- Bus rider information should arrive at your home soon (if your child is eligible for bus service)
- 6<sup>th</sup> graders will report to the Commons (cafeteria)
- 7<sup>th</sup> graders will report to the Boys' Gym
- 8<sup>th</sup> graders will report to the Girls' Gym

## Volleyball and Football Information (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Graders)

- Volleyball Tryouts are August 23, 24, and 25 from 6:45 to 8:15 AM. Arrive at the bus ramp entrance between 6:30 and 6:45 AM. Doors will be locked at 6:45, therefore please do not be late. Be sure to attend ALL tryouts (be present all three days), have your physical on file with the coaches by August 23<sup>rd</sup>, and have all of your forms completed online at <u>www.rankonesport.com</u>
- **Football** Physicals must be on file with the coaches before receiving equipment, along with the completion of all online forms at <u>www.rankonesport.com</u>. Coaches will distribute football equipment on Thursday, August 17<sup>th</sup>, 6:00-8:00 PM for students who missed equipment distribution on August 12<sup>th</sup>, and who have completed all the needed paperwork.
