- All Students: In each area there will be an alphabetical list of names on the wall. Students will find their name on their grade level list, and then find the name of their first period teacher. Then, the student will go sit at that teacher's table or in that teacher's line, which is marked with the teacher's name.

# First Day of School Reminders

- Sugar Land MS strives to maintain a welcoming, yet safe environment and to give superior customer service to our community. On the first day of school, please support our transition process, and allow your middle-schooler to enter the building independently, unless you are dropping off medication at the clinic or have a pre-arranged meeting. Parents will have the opportunity to visit their child's classes at Open House on September 7<sup>th</sup>, and they are welcome to come to our Make-Up Orientation this Thursday evening between 6:00 and 8:00 PM
- School Hours: 8:55 (tardy bell) to 4:10 (dismissal)
